Never before in the history of intercollegiate athletics has the spotlight shown so brightly on the athletic programs and championships being administered in our nation's institutions of higher learning. The National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) accepts the challenge of integrating competitive athletics participation with the overall educational experience.

The NAIA is a completely autonomous association currently administering intercollegiate athletics programs to nearly 500 fully-accredited colleges and universities across the United States and in Canada, and is organized into 32 geographical districts.

More than 80,000 student-athletes participate annually in NAIA-sanctioned varsity athletics programs. The Association administers 21 separate championships covering 13 sports, and NAIA member schools comprise approximately 40 percent of the four-year collegiate athletics programs offered in the United States.

Anniversaries symbolize strength and stability, and the NAIA is proud to celebrate its Golden Anniversary throughout the 1990-91 academic year. Established in 1940 as the National Association of Intercollegiate Basketball (NAIB), the NAIA emanated from the "National Small College Basketball Tournament" inaugurated in 1937 in Kansas City, Missouri.

The conversion of the NAIB to the NAIA came in 1952 when the Association added national championships in golf, tennis and outdoor track and field. Baseball, cross country, football and swimming and diving were added to the championship calendar in 1956. More recent additions include indoor track and field, soccer, softball, volleyball and wrestling.

Throughout its 50-year history, the NAIA has been at the forefront of many progressive social movements. The

first national collegiate association to allow minority participation and representation from historically black colleges, the NAIA also pioneered the way for greater prominence in women's athletics programs, establishing a women's division on August 1, 1980.

In keeping with the philosophy of administering athletics programs in concert with the student-athlete's academic experience, the registrars, faculty athletics representatives, and presidents and chancellors of the NAIA member schools participate in the governance of the Association alongside athletics directors, coaches, sports information directors, and affiliated conference officials.

The colleges and universities of the NAIA, although varied and diverse, share a common commitment to the highest standards in intercollegiate athletics. Eligibility rules within the NAIA govern play in all sports recognized by the Association, not just postseason competition. Eligibility guidelines must be adhered to by all members, including institutions holding dual affiliations.

Association member schools in 1988 overwhelmingly adopted academic eligibility standards which impose the strictest standards of any association for

participating NAIA student-athletes. Current NAIA academic eligibility requirements mandate that a student-athlete make steady progress toward an academic degree, not only at the beginning of the collegiate career, but also into the second, third and fourth years of the collegiate experience.

The National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics stands prepared to administer programs of intercollegiate athletics which provide "education through athletics" for each and every NAIA student-athlete.
