CEDARVILLE AND RIO GRANDE LEAD MOC

With just three games remaining to be played in MOC regular season competition, Cedarville College holds a one-game lead over Rio Grande. The Yellow Jackets and Redmen meet at Rio the last game of the season for what could decide the championship. Both teams scored victories by just one point this week. On Tuesday Rio trailed host Urbana College by 1 point with less than 20 seconds remaining. Watson McDonald (Rio) was fouled. He made the first free throw and missed the second one, but Kevin Castleman tipped it in giving the Redmen a 2-point lead. Seconds later an Urbana player was fouled but was only able to make one of two free throws, as the Blue Knights lost their third game in a row. The absence of Lonnell Currie from the Urbana lineup last week hurt Urbana badly as they also lost to Malone. In a nip and tuck battle that went into overtime Cedarville defeated Walsh 73-72. With 8 seconds remaining in overtime and Cedarville trailing 72-71 Eric Mounts was fouled. He made good on both free throws to give the Yellow Jackets a 73-72 lead. The Cavaliers called time out with 6 seconds remaining to set up a play, but the ball rolled around the rim and out. A last-second tipin attempt failed as the Yellow Jacket fans held their breath.

Rio Grande easily defeated Mount Vernon as Kevin Castleman scored 28 points and Watson McDonald collected 20 rebounds. Tom Dorsey contributed 17 points shooting 80% from the field. A key to the loss was the absence of Jeff Madden from the Cougar lineup. Madden, who returned to the lineup last week, was in bed at Mount Vernon with the flu.

Senior guard Dan Anderson of Tiffin broke the all-time scoring record at Tiffin University of 1452 points held by Jim Huss. Anderson scored 15 points in the Walsh contest, breaking the record, and 22 points against Ohio Dominican to bring his total to 1487 points. Ed Baldwin has returned to the Ohio Dominican lineup following a knee injury sustained in a fall.
