#### CEDARVILLE MOC CHAMPIONS

The Cedarville College Yellow Jackets, led by Eric Mounts' 40 points, defeated Tiffin 93-89 in overtime to clinch the Mid-Ohio Conference regular season championship with a record of 12-1. The Jackets received help from Malone as the Pioneers defeated Rio Grande, dropping the Redmen's record to 10-3. The Pioneers have been playing very well lately, only losing one game since beginning the second round of conference play. Rio has had to play the last two contests without the services of Watson McDonald and Kevin Castleman due to some eligibility problems. As a result of the eligibility situation, at this time it does not appear that Rio Grande will be participating in the conference tournament which begins Thursday.

The post-season MOC tourney is for the purpose of determining the MOC representative to the NAIA District 22 playoffs. The four teams with the best winning percentage in conference play will qualify. With each MOC team having one game yet to be played, a host site and fourth position are at stake. The pairings are as follows: Cedarville will host either Urbana or Tiffin and Walsh and Malone will play with the host site yet to be determined. The finals will be on Saturday at the home court of the higher seeded team remaining.

Rick Acord and Tom Jutze, two freshmen, picked up the slack in the Rio lineup as the Redmen defeated Ohio Dominican. Acord scored 20 points and collected 7 rebounds and Jutze 15 rebounds. Vince Phelps led the Redmen with 12 assists as they lost to host Malone.
