Graduate Certificate in Nursing Education

The Graduate Certificate in Nursing Education enhances the Master of Science in Nursing degree by equipping students to teach in healthcare or education settings. Adding to students' advanced practice nursing skills, they gain core knowledge in curriculum design, evidence-based teaching and learning strategies, and assessment and evaluation strategies for education. This certificate helps prepare students to teach in healthcare or education settings as a nurse education, staff educator, clinical faculty member, or continuing education provider.

Graduate Certificate in Nursing Leadership

The Graduate Certificate in Nursing Leadership prepares students to effectively serve and lead in the nursing field. This certificate enabled them to develop and apply the skills demanded of nurse leaders. The foundation of knowledge they develop in topics including organizational behavior, quality and safety, and strategic decision-making, enable them to be an effective leader in multiple healthcare settings. This certificate helps prepare students to collaborate with a diverse team of medical providers to ensure the delivery of evidence-based patient care.

Graduate Certificate in Global Public Health Nursing

The Graduate Certificate in Global Public Health Nursing uniquely positions students to address trends in contemporary nursing practice, domestically and globally. The certificate program allows students to add core knowledge related to health ministry, epidemiology, global health issues, and population-focused nursing care to their advanced nursing practice.

Nursing Honor Society (NHS)
