## Scoring

The meet will be scored on a 10-8-6-4-2-1 basis.

## Awards

**All-American** -- The first place finisher in each individual event and the first place team members in each relay will be named NCCAA All-American. They will receive an All-American certificate and plaque and their institution will also receive a certificate. All other placers will receive an achievement certificate indicating the event and finishing place. Any Division II student-athlete finishing in the top three in a particular event will be awarded All-American status.

**At-Large All-Americans** -- Six men and six women will be selected At-Large All-Americans based on the best non-winning performances as determined by objective (top ten all-time performances) and subjective analysis by the At-Large All-American Committee.

**Coach of the Year** -- The men's and women's Coach of the Year awards will be decided by a vote of the respective coaches at the close of the meet and presented at the meet awards ceremony.

**Division I and Division II Outstanding Performance Awards** -- These awards for both men and women will be selected by a vote of the respective coaches immediately at the conclusion of the meet. Plaques will be presented by the Track Sports Chair immediately following the vote.

**NCCAA Scholar-Athletes** -- Men's and women's athletes who meet NCCAA academic qualifications and are nominated by their coach will be eligible for the NCCAA Scholar-Athlete team. Those honored will receive a certificate.

**NCCAA Certificates of Participation** -- These will be given to all student-athletes competing in the National Track and Field Meet.

**Team Awards** -- For both the men and women, the NCCAA track championship banner will be awarded to the first place team, and plaques will be given to the next three teams.

## The Wheeler Track and Field Award

The awards, for men and women, are sponsored by John and Joanne Wheeler who have been involved in the athletic activities of Christian high schools and colleges for several years. Mr. and Mrs. Wheeler have each had a continuing and active participation in the area of athletics and wish to promote athletics in Christian colleges.

The awards were established in order to enhance excellence in Christian track and field competition and to perpetuate the Christian philosophy and faith as exemplified through Christ-like track and field participation in NCCAA member colleges and universities.

Candidates are nominated by their track and field coaches with final selection of the recipients made by a committee composed of the track and field sport chair, vice-chair, national meet director, and the highest ranking National Executive Committee member present at the meet. Presentation of the awards will be in ceremonies following the meet.

Recipients must each be a team member of a Christian college recognized by the NCCAA; must each possess a vital Christian testimony on and off the track; must each exhibit outstanding leadership qualities including Christian service activities; must each be highly skilled in track and field; must each be a junior or senior student in good academic standing; must each be a participant in the national meet of the year of nomination.

A trophy descriptive of the honor will be awarded each recipient recognizing the honor. A similar trophy will be awarded each recipient's institution recognizing the honor as well.

# History and Philosophy of the National Christian College Athletic Association

The NCCAA, with national headquarters in Marion, Indiana, is a miracle organization. In just a few years an idea has become a reality providing Christian student-athletes in Christian colleges both an opportunity for fellowship and competition on the national level.

Established in 1966 in Canton, Ohio, the NCCAA held its first basketball tournament in Detroit, Michigan in 1968. At the initial tournament, the NCCAA adopted a constitution and voted to move the national headquarters to Chattanooga, Tennessee upon invitation of the Chamber of Commerce.

In 1973 the NCCAA launched into other sports developing national competition in cross country, track and field, and soccer. Bible colleges, which had competed well against liberal arts colleges, submitted a plan to add a second division. Division II basketball was developed in 1975 for the Bible colleges (non-scholarship), along with wrestling.

The NCCAA game plan is to produce true winners; a game plan that will carry an individual through his or her entire life. The game plan is devised to draw out the student-athlete's greatest potential -- body, mind, and spirit.

This game plan is catching on virtually all over the United States. Since its first tournament in 1968, the NCCAA has grown to encompass more than 100 Christian colleges nationwide, both liberal arts and Bible colleges in nature. The participating schools are dedicated not only to the best athletic competition possible, but also to exemplify Jesus Christ in everything.

The NCCAA believes:

- That athletics are a means to an end, not an end in themselves.
- That the process is as important as the performance.
- That the person (student-athlete) is more important than the program.

Athletics in a Christian liberal arts or Bible college are unique experiences which prepare Christian men and women for a life of meaningful work and service. The athletic experience provides a dynamic growth process for learning discipline, team work, leadership, and mutual respect where the student-athlete and his preparation for life is more important to the coaches and the athletic administration than won-loss records and championships.

For the student-athlete who wants to be a part of a team that competes on a district, regional, and national level but realizes the importance of his education within a biblical perspective, and for the coach who wants his team to represent Jesus Christ, NCCAA is the right game plan for them.

For the spectator who wants a game that can draw enthusiastic responses, but wants to know the participating teams are living beyond the outcome of the game, NCCAA is the right game plan for him.

NCCAA. It is an organization bringing Christian colleges together not just for athletic competition. More importantly, it is an organization bringing colleges together who have common goals and perspectives in Christian higher education.
