## HARRIERS OPEN SEASON

The Cedarville College men's and women's cross country teams officially opened their seasons Saturday in quadrangular meets at Bellarmine College in Louisville, Kentucky. The Yellow Jacket women won their meet with 43 points followed by Louisville 49, Bellarmine 53, and Georgetown 73.

Senior Jane Romig paced the squad with a first-place time of 20:12 for the 5,000 meters. Sue Vaughan was fifth, Deb Pate sixth, Beth McGillivray 16th, and Becky Averil 19th.

The men totaled 44 points but were surprised by Vincennes which had 35. Louisville finished with 47 and Bellarmine 100. Junior Rob Moore ran the 8,000 meters in 25:52 and placed second. Tom Hill finished seventh, John Oswald eighth, J.P. Dawes 15th, and Scott Brooker 18th.

Both teams will compete in the Taylor (IN) University Invitational on Saturday.
