YELLOW JACKET SOCCER OPENS SEASON 2-1

The Yellow Jacket kickers compiled a 2-1 record after the first week of the season. Head coach, John McGillivray is for the most part pleased with his team's performances considering the short one week of soccer camp in preparation for the opener with Denison University on Tuesday, September 14.

The lone goal in the 1-0 victory over Denison was scored in the second half by sophomore, Wayne Anderson on an assist by freshman, Tom Fite. Cedarville's goalie, Gary Layton had 11 saves in the bout.

Cedarville fell in the first round of the Cedarville Invitational Soccer Tournament to University of Dayton 2-1. The half-time score was tied at one each. The Yellow Jacket goal coming from another freshman, Noel Hack assisted by sophomore, Mark Price. The Flyers of U.D. picked up two more goals before the final buzzer to take the 3-1 win.

Cedarville easily handled Bethel College, IN, in the consolation game with a 9-1 victory bringing the season record to 2-1. The leading scorer for Cedarville was sophomore, Mark Price, with 3 goals. One goal each was scored by Steve Smith, Dave Jones, Wayne Anderson, Noel Hack, Jeff Smith and Dan Barfell.

It would seem that the Yellow Jacket youth will be playing a major role in the scoring column this season. Of the 11 goals and 9 assists on the Yellow Jacket stats books this week, 9 goals were scored and 6 assists were given by freshmen or sophomores.

Spring Arbor College, MI, became the Cedarville Invitational Soccer Tournament champions by defeating U.D. 2-1. MVP of the Tournament went to Paul Kato of Spring Arbor.

KING ENCOURAGED BY HARRIERS RUN AT GRACE

The cross country team appears to have regained, at least in part, its strength of 2 years ago. In the Grace Invitational Meet, Winona Lake, IN, Tom Hill lead the Cedarville pack and took third overall in the meet with a time of 26:25 (just 12 seconds behind the #1 runner). Cedarville placed third in the meet with 97 points behind Anderson's 42, and Manchester's 52.

Head coach, Elvin King, was pleased with the improvement since the Defiance meet held one week earlier. In that meet, the Yellow Jacket harriers ran well behind Tri-State who this week Cedarville defeated.

Volleyball camp opened Monday, September 20. More evidence that the summer is quickly winding down at Cedarville and that the arrival of students is just around the corner. (Saturday, Sept. 25). Coach Elaine Brown will be the new coach at the spikers helm.
