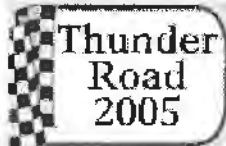

Spaulding grad shines in Ohio

CEDARVILLE, Ohio – Spaulding High School graduate Aaron Griggs recently completed his first season as a member of the men's track and field team at Cedarville University in Ohio. He was part of a Yellow Jacket squad that placed third in the National Christian College Athletic Association Outdoor Championship and finished 34th out of 104 teams at the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics Outdoor Championship.

Griggs is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Scott Griggs of Orange.

Griggs, a freshman communications major, posted a season-best 4:24.54 in the 1500 meter run at the Miami University Invitational. He was part of the 4x800 meter relay squad that produced a 8:32.40 effort to finish fourth at the Taylor University Invitational.

Cedarville finished second in the American Midwest Conference Championship. The Yellow Jackets won the Cedarville Open and the Emory University Classic.
