- 12 - Joy Fagan: Averaged 10.1 points a game for last year's 13-14 team. English Secondary Education major.
- 24 - Lynn Strickland: Averaged 17.9 points and 14.2 rebounds last year in 16 games after becoming eligible at mid-season. Number two votegetter on the All-Western Buckeye Collegiate Conference team. Business Finance major.
- 30 - Linda Bean: Her second year in the program, and a Physical Education major.
- 32 - Gina Ray: A sophomore who is a Physical Education/Psychology major.
- 34 - Tammy Mascari: Averaged 6.0 points and 5.0 rebounds in 22 games last year following volleyball season. Outstanding volleyball player for Cedarville this fall which posted a best-ever 31-13 record and made the NAIA District 22 playoffs. She led the netters in blocking and was second in kills. Physical Education major.
- 40 - Chris Friesen: Soon to become fourth female in Cedarville College basketball history to score 1,000 career points. Entered game on Nov. 29 against Taylor, Ind. with 969. Averaged 14.4 points and 10.0 rebounds per game last year. All-WBCC in both basketball and softball. Mathematics major.
- 42 - Shelly Smith: Freshman from Osseo, Michigan.
- 44 - Diane Rank: Scored 23 points and grabbed 18 rebounds in her first collegiate game on Nov. 18 at Transylvania, Ky. Her efforts keyed a 79-74 upset in overtime for Cedarville which avenged last year's 23-point loss to the same team. Office Technology major.
