Violinist and Conductor **Jun Kim** has played numerous recitals and concerts throughout the United States and Canada. He has been featured in master classes of Cho-liang Lin, Pamela Frank, Federico Agostini, and Sergiu Schwart and has participated in the Aspen Music Festival, Bowdoin Music Festival, and Aria International Music Festival. Jun Kim has won prizes and awards in numerous competitions including the Starling Competition, the CCM Concerto Competition, the Tuesday Musical Competition of Akron, CIBC Canada National Competition, and the Vancouver Youth Symphony Concerto Competition. Professor Kim also has been the recipient of the Aspen Music Festival Fellowship, British Columbia Cultural Scholarship, and the Peabody Merit Scholarship, among others. Mr. Kim earned Degrees in violin performance in prestigious schools such as Peabody Institute of Johns Hopkins University, Indiana University, and an Artist Diploma from the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music (CCM). He is currently completing his Doctorate degree at CCM. Professor Kim has served as a violin teaching assistant to Dr. Won-Bin Yim at CCM and at the Aspen Music Festival, and he has served as a member of the violin faculty in CCM's preparatory department. His violin teachers include Victor Danchenko, Miriam Fried, and Ik-hwan Bae. Jun Kim serves as assistant professor of violin and conducts the Cedarville University Orchestra.

Pianist and composer **John Mortensen** received his education from the University of Michigan and the University of Maryland, studying piano with Lynne Bartholomew, Anne Koscielny, and Raymond Hanson. Central California's leading newspaper has described his performing as "hauntingly beautiful" and "full of energy and bravura." In 2008 the Russian press wrote about him as follows: "How does one judge the masterful performance of the pianist? In the hall were teachers from the school of arts, admirers of contemporary classics... Only a professional of the very highest level compels the sensitive soul to respond and weep, laugh and love together with his instrument." Dr. Mortensen serves as professor of piano at Cedarville University.

As an active chamber musician and pedagogue, Cellist **Sae Rom Kwon** has been invited to give recitals in Canada, South Korea, and throughout the United States. Her appearances include the Winner's Concert at the Coleman Chamber Music Competition, Eastman Chamber Music Society Concert Series, Buffalo Chamber Music Series and Young Artist Series at Young-San Art Hall. She was a fellowship recipient to Aspen Music Festival and Kneisel Hall Summer Festival. This past summer, she was invited as a junior faculty member to teach and perform at Bowdoin International Music Festival. Ms. Kwon holds a Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree from Eastman School of Music where she served as a teaching assistant to Alan Harris. She is now pursuing her Doctorate Degree in cello performance under the tutelage of Yehuda Hanani at CCM. She currently plays with the Ohio Valley Symphony as principal cellist and teaches Cello/Bass at Murray State University as an adjunct faculty.
