Season Outlook

The 1984 Cedarville College soccer team will feature the return of eleven lettermen from a squad that went 10-6-2 a year ago. Included in that group are last season's top two scorers Tom Fite and Wayne Anderson. Fite, a junior co-captain from Milford, led the squad with 28 points (10 goals, 8 assists) despite missing three contests. Anderson, a senior from Hamburg, New York, led the Jackets in goals scored with 12 and added three assists for 27 points. Noel Hack, a junior co-captain from Lagrange, is back as a two-year letterwinner as is senior Chuck Abel, a back from Covington, Kentucky.

McGillivray plans on using a lot of players this season with hopes of developing his usual balanced offensive attack. For a successful season, the goalkeeper position will need to be shored up with the departure of NAIA Academic All-American Bill Jaquis.

Profiles

- COACH JOHN MCGILLIVRAY - Begins his eleventh year at the Yellow Jacket helm with a career record of 94-71-9. Has guided C.C. to seven MOC titles (three outright), three NAIA District 22 crowns, and one NAIA Area IV championship in 1974 when the Jackets placed sixth at the national tournament. Three-time District 22 "Coach of the Year" ('74, '75, '78) and once named Area IV "Coach of the Year" in 1974. He and his wife Bonnie reside in Cedarville along with their five children.
- WAYNE ANDERSON (2) - Jackets number two scorer last season (12 goals, 3 assists) and made NAIA District 22 second team. Two-year letterwinner at forward position. Scored both goals in 2-1 win over Wittenberg last year. Also scored twice against Walsh and Malone. Has good eye for the net.
- CURT CRITCHER (7) - Named to NAIA District 22 second team in '83. Recognized as Yellow Jackets "Best Defensive Player." Heads up Cedarville's back line forces.
- TOM FITE (11)
Co-Captain - Led team in scoring a year ago (10 goals, 8 assists) being picked to NAIA District 22 second team for second straight year. Had 2-goal, 1-assist outings in wins over both Northern Kentucky and Tiffin. Best ballhandler on the squad.
- NOEL HACK (15)
Co-Captain - Had three goals and four assists last year and missed four games due to injury. Two-year letterwinner at forward position. Solid team leader expected to have best season of career if he stays healthy.

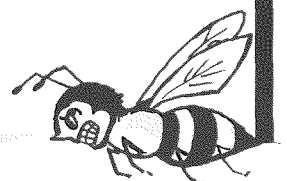
