CEDARVILLE, OHIO -- Lisa Kelly, a graduate of Mansfield Christian High School, is a member of the women's varsity basketball team at Cedarville College. Lisa carries an elementary education major and is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Larry Kelly of Galion.

Kelly, who is a freshman forward, is one of nine newcomers to the Yellow Jacket program this winter. She enjoyed a fine career at Mansfield Christian where she averaged 13.3 points and 12.5 rebounds per game her senior year.

Cedarville has struggled out to a 3-9 start through games of Jan. 16. Coach Bob Fires lost four starters and nearly 50 points per game from last year's 20-10 club. That was a school record for victories in a season as the Yellow Jackets made the NAIA District 22 playoffs and later finished as the runner-up in the National Christian College Athletic Association (NCCAA) national tournament.

Cedarville is a Baptist liberal arts college located in southwestern Ohio, 25 miles east of Dayton. The school has an enrollment of approximately 1900 students.
