CEDARVILLE, OHIO -- Piketon High School graduate Mindy Humble is a member of the women's varsity basketball at Cedarville College. She is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Michael Humble of 114 Main St. in Piketon.

Humble, a freshman guard, is one of only two players who has started all 12 games for the Yellow Jackets. She is fourth on the team in scoring with 68 points for an average of 5.7 per game, plus she leads the club in three-point field goals with 13 and in assists with 32.

Cedarville has a 3-9 record through games of Jan. 16, and the tough start can be attributed to the youth on the team.

"This may be the youngest team we've ever had," remarked coach Bob Fires, who lost four starters from last year's 20-10 squad. "We have started four freshmen for most of the season and Mindy has gained a lot of experience as one of those starters." Humble is tops on the club in minutes played with an average of 30 per game.

Mindy has scored in double figures three times this season. Her high was a 14-point effort in a 63-58 victory at Ohio Dominican back on Nov. 21.

Cedarville is a Baptist liberal arts college located in southwestern Ohio, 25 miles east of Dayton. The school has an enrollment of approximately 1900 students.
