MOC, NAIA SOCCER TEAMS RELEASED

Cedarville College was well-represented on the Mid-Ohio Conference and NAIA District 22 soccer teams that were recently announced. The 10-7-1 Yellow Jackets have yet to complete their season as they will be competing in the NCCAA national tournament next week in Longview, Texas.

Curt Critcher, a senior back from Wickliffe, Ohio, was named the recipient of the J. Albert Turner Award as the MVP of the Mid-Ohio Conference. He was also named to the NAIA District 22 first team.

Junior co-captain and midfielder Tom Fite was named to the first team in both the conference and district. The Milford, Ohio native leads the Jackets in scoring with 16 goals and six assists in 14 games.

Forward Noel Hack, the team's other junior co-captain, was also selected to the District 22 and MOC first teams. He is from Lagrange, Ohio and is Cedarville's second-leading scorer with 12 goals and 12 assists in 18 games.

Named to both the MOC and District 22 second teams were sophomore midfielder Brent Ziegler (Wellington, OH), and sophomore back Greg Norden (Arcadia, OH). Senior goalkeeper Jan Schaedel (Mattituck, NY) was picked to the district's second team.
