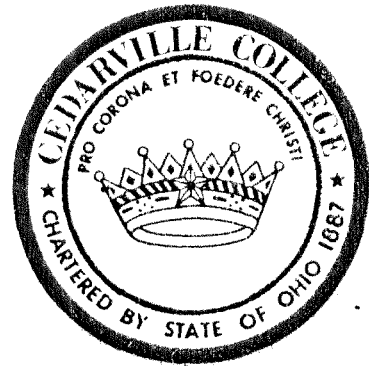
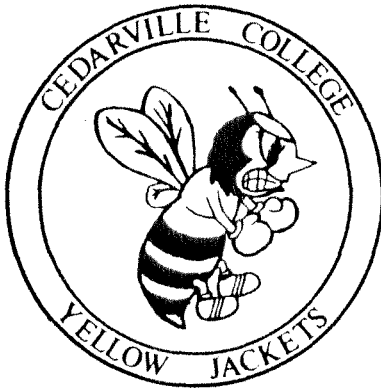

CEDARVILLE COLLEGE

CEDARVILLE COLLEGE IS A BAPTIST COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCES OF APPROXIMATELY 1800 STUDENTS. THE SCHOOL IS LOCATED IN THE RURAL COMMUNITY OF CEDARVILLE, OHIO, WHICH IS 25 MILES EAST OF DAYTON AND 12 MILES SOUTH OF SPRINGFIELD. FOUNDED IN 1887 BY THE REFORMED PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH, IT WAS ESTABLISHED BY INDIVIDUALS WHO HAD A VITAL INTEREST IN THE SPIRITUAL WELFARE OF YOUNG PEOPLE. IN 1953, THE OPERATION OF THE COLLEGE WAS TRANSFERRED TO THE TRUSTEES OF BAPTIST BIBLE INSTITUTE OF CLEVELAND WITH THE GOAL OF ENLARGING THE INSTITUTE'S MINISTRY. THE NAME, CEDARVILLE COLLEGE, WAS RETAINED AND THE SCHOOL CONTINUES TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL PURPOSE OF ITS FOUNDERS. THE SCHOOL MOTTO, "...FOR THE WORD OF GOD AND TESTIMONY OF JESUS CHRIST," REFLECTS THIS COMMITMENT.

THE COLLEGE PROGRAM IS DESIGNED TO PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDENTS TO DEVELOP BALANCED LIVES. SUCH LIVES ARE PRODUCED BY AN OVERALL PROGRAM WHICH ENCOURAGES ACADEMIC, SPIRITUAL, SOCIAL, AND PHYSICAL GROWTH SIMULTANEOUSLY. STUDENT LIFE, WHICH INVOLVES EACH OF THESE ASPECTS, IS CONSEQUENTLY SEEN AS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE COLLEGE LEARNING EXPERIENCE. 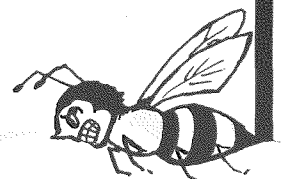

HEAD SOCCER COACH

CEDARVILLE COLLEGE

CAREER RECORD: 104-78-10

THE ELEVEN YEARS THAT JOHN MCGILLIVRAY HAS SPENT AS HEAD SOCCER COACH AT CEDARVILLE COLLEGE HAVE POSSIBLY BEEN THE MOST PROSPEROUS IN THE SPORT FOR THE YELLOW JACKETS. HE HAS GUIDED THE C.C. KICKERS TO SEVEN MID-OHIO CONFERENCE TITLES (THREE OUTHRIGHT), THREE NAIA DISTRICT 22 CROWNS, THREE NCCAA DISTRICT III TITLES, AND ONE NAIA AREA IV CHAMPIONSHIP IN 1974 WHEN THE JACKETS PLACED SIXTH IN THE NATIONAL TOURNAMENT. MCGILLIVRAY WAS ALSO NAMED NCCAA NATIONAL "COACH OF THE YEAR" IN 1981 WHEN THE JACKETS FINISHED IN THE RUNNER-UP SLOT AFTER LOSING TO MESSIAH 2-1 IN THE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME.

WHAT MAGNIFIES THE ABOVE ACCOMPLISHMENTS IS THE FACT THAT WHEN MCGILLIVRAY TOOK OVER THE SOCCER HELM IN 1974, HE HAD NO PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE IN THE SPORT. DR. DON CALLAN, WHO IS THE ATHLETIC DIRECTOR AT CEDARVILLE, TALKED HIM INTO TAKING THE VACANT POSITION. THROUGH ATTENDING SOCCER COACHING CLINICS PLUS HARD WORK AND STUDY, MCGILLIVRAY HAS DEVELOPED INTO ONE OF THE BEST COACHES THAT CEDARVILLE HAS EVER HAD.

MCGILLIVRAY HAS BEEN HONORED BY HIS PEERS AS THE NAIA DISTRICT 22 "COACH OF THE YEAR" THREE TIMES ('74, '75, '78) AND HE RECEIVED THE SAME HONOR FOR NAIA AREA IV ONCE IN 1974. HE IS CURRENTLY THE PRESIDENT OF THE NAIA SOCCER COACHES ASSOCIATION.

A 1970 GRADUATE OF CEDARVILLE COLLEGE, MCGILLIVRAY HAS SEVERAL OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES BESIDES BEING THE SOCCER COACH. HE IS A PROFESSOR IN THE PHYSICAL EDUCATION DEPARTMENT AND THE COACH OF THE WOMEN'S TRACK TEAM.

JOHN AND HIS WIFE BONNIE RESIDE IN CEDARVILLE ALONG WITH THEIR FIVE CHILDREN.

CEDARVILLE COLLEGE SOCCER 1984 SEASON

RIGHT BEFORE THE 1984 YELLOW JACKET SOCCER SEASON OPENED, COACH JOHN MCGILLIVRAY EXPRESSED MUCH CONCERN OVER THE LACK OF EXPERIENCE ON HIS TEAM ESPECIALLY AT THE GOALKEEPING SLOT. BUT THE DEFENSE PROVED TO BE MUCH BETTER THAN EXPECTED BY ALLOWING NO MORE THAN TWO GOALS IN ANY ONE GAME THROUGH THE FIRST TEN CONTESTS DESPITE A 4-5-1 RECORD. FOLLOWING A 4-0 LOSS TO NAIA-POWER WILMINGTON COLLEGE, THE JACKET OFFENSE BEGAN TO CLICK AND C.C. WON SIX OF ITS LAST SEVEN OUTINGS TO CURRENTLY STAND AT 10-7-1. THE ONLY LOSS IN THAT SPAN WAS AGAIN TO WILMINGTON IN THE NAIA DISTRICT 22 TITLE GAME.

FIRST-YEAR GOALKEEPERS DAN BYRUM AND JAN SCHAEDEL HAVE DONE A TREMENDOUS JOB IN THE NETS WITH THE HELP OF SENIOR BACK CURT CRITCHER. SCHAEDEL HAS POSTED TWO SHUTOUTS THIS YEAR AND THE TANDEM HAS COMBINED FOR THREE OTHERS. THE BEST OUTING BY A C.C. GOALKEEPER THIS YEAR CAME IN THE NAIA DISTRICT 22 PLAYOFFS WHEN SCHAEDEL BLANKED TIFFIN 1-0 TO AVENGE A REGULAR SEASON LOSS TO THE DRAGONS.

JUNIOR CO-CAPTAINS TOM FITE AND NOEL HACK HAVE PACED THE OFFENSIVE ATTACK SCORING 28 OF THE TEAM'S 58 GOALS. FITE HAS HAD AN OUTSTANDING YEAR (16 GOALS, 6 ASSISTS) WHILE MISSING FOUR GAMES. HACK HAD BOTH OF CEDARVILLE'S GOALS IN THE NCCAA DISTRICT III CHAMPIONSHIP VICTORY AT GRACE.

THREE OF CEDARVILLE'S BIGGEST VICTORIES IN '84 INCLUDE BEING THE ONLY MOC TEAM TO BEAT MT. VERNON IN A 2-1 WIN. THE JACKETS EMOTION-FILLED 1-0 WIN AT TIFFIN IN THE NAIA DISTRICT PLAYOFFS RANKS HIGH, AS DOES CEDARVILLE'S 2-1 VICTORY AT GRACE IN THE NCCAA DISTRICT III CHAMPIONSHIP TILT.

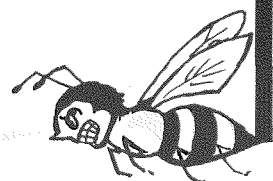
