Amy Zehr earns two Player of the Year honors

CEDARVILLE, OHIO -- Cedarville College senior Amy Zehr has been named women's basketball Player of the Year in both NAIA District 22 Division II and the Mid-Ohio Conference for the 1992-93 season. The 5-9 forward from Fort Wayne, Ind. is the first Lady Jacket to ever be selected for either honor.

Zehr is averaging 25.1 points and 14.2 rebounds per game for Cedarville, which enters the NAIA District 22 tournament with an 18-9 record. She has led the district and MOC in scoring and rebounding the entire season.

Zehr ranks fourth nationally in NAIA Division II in both scoring and rebounding. Her .601 field goal percentage rates sixth.

"Amy is a terrific player and an outstanding person," says Cedarville head coach Kathy Freese. "She has had a super year on the court and she is a model student-athlete for everyone who comes in contact with her. We think she's an All-America player."

Zehr is the Lady Jackets' all-time leading rebounder with 1,053 boards and her 1,646 points rate third in the school's history. She holds single game records for most points scored (41), rebounds (26), and steals (8). The 368 rebounds she has snared this year broke her own single season mark of 336 set last year.

Zehr was selected the NAIA Division II national women's basketball Player of the Week the first week of January. She was also tabbed NAIA Division II national defensive women's Player of the Week the same week as selected by *Don Hansen's Basketball Gazette* and released in *USA Today*.
