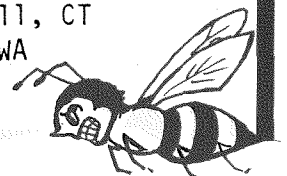

## 1985 SEASON OUTLOOK

Six of eleven starters are gone from last year's NCCAA District III championship team that went 11-8-1 and placed fifth at the NCCAA Nationals. However, Coach John McGillivray has reason to believe that enough talent is back this fall to produce another winner.

The top three scorers return in seniors Tom Fite, Noel Hack, and Dan Hawk, however, the entire back line will need to be replaced. Sophomore keeper Steve Racz is expected to do an adequate job after playing on the junior varsity last season. Junior Greg Norden will move to a back position after playing two years at midfield.

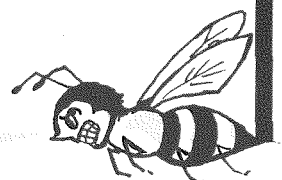
McGillivray has high hopes for several newcomers including Paul Norman, Derek Whalen, Steve Hanson, and Loren Tucker.

The 1985 schedule is highlighted with the likes of Denison, Wittenberg, Northern Kentucky, Tiffin, and Wilmington. The Jackets will also play under the lights in Xenia against Urbana.

Head Soccer Coach

Begins his 12th year at the Yellow Jacket helm with a career record of 105-79-10. Has guided Cedarville to seven MOC titles (three outright), three NAIA District 22 crowns, and one NAIA Area IV championship in 1974 when the Jackets placed sixth at the national tournament. Has taken two teams to NCCAA Nationals finishing second in 1981 and was national "Coach of the Year." Three-time NAIA District 22 "Coach of the Year" (1974, 75, 78) and once named NAIA Area IV "Coach of the Year" in 1974. John and his wife Bonnie reside in Cedarville along with their five children.

TOM FITE  
5-9 150 SR MF Milford, OH

NCCAA First Team All-American last fall and made NCCAA national all-tournament team where Jackets placed fifth. Picked to NSCAA All-Mideast NAIA First Team and All-Ohio Third Team. Led squad in scoring with 42 points (18 goals, 6 assists) despite missing four games. Scored two or more goals in five games last year. First team member in both NAIA District 22 and Mid-Ohio Conference. Best ballhandler on the team.

NAIA Academic All-American last fall and was voted team M.P. Named to OSCA All-Academic first team, plus NAIA District 22 and Mid-Ohio Conference first teams. Had school record five assists against Marion and had a four-goal effort versus Findlay. Team's second-leading scorer with 36 points (12 goals, 12 assists). Yellow Jacket Club's Male Athlete of the Year" for 1984-85.

## 1984 SEASON WRAP-UP

Right before the 1984 Yellow Jacket soccer season opened, Coach John McGillivray expressed much concern over the lack of experience on his team especially at the goalkeeping slot. But the defense proved to be much better than expected by allowing no more than two goals in any one game through the first ten contests despite a 4-5-1 record. Following a 4-0 loss to NAIA-power Wilmington College, the Jacket offense began to click and C.C. won seven of its last nine outings to finish at 11-8-1.

First-year goalkeepers Dan Byrum and Jan Schaedel did a tremendous job in the nets with the help of senior back Curt Critcher. Schaedel posted two shutouts this year and the tandem combined for three others. The best outing by a C.C. goalkeeper this season came in the NAIA District 22 playoffs when Schaedel blanked Tiffin 1-0 to avenge a regular season loss to the Dragons.

Junior co-captains Tom Fite and Noel Hack paced the offensive attack scoring 30 of the team's 63 goals. Fite had an outstanding year (18 goals, 6 assists) while missing four games. Hack had both of Cedarville's goals in the 2-1 NCCAA District III championship victory at Grace.

The Jackets made their second-ever trip to the NCCAA Nationals finishing fifth in the six-team tournament held in Longview, Texas. Cedarville lost to host LeTourneau 2-1 and then defeated Roberts Wesleyan 4-1. Fite was named all-tournament after scoring one goal in each game.

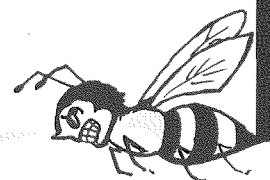

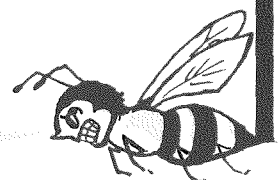

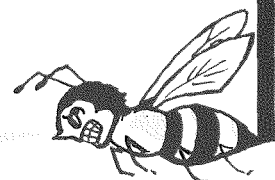
