1989 SEASON OUTLOOK



Cedarville begins its 27th year of varsity soccer and the Yellow Jackets will be seeking their ninth straight winning season. The '80's have been good to Coach JOHN MCGILLIVRAY'S teams as they have posted a 99-68-10 record during the decade.

The Yellow Jackets are coming off of their second straight 11-9-1 season and they are the defending NCCAA District III champs. But some key players graduated including two-time NAIA-NSCAA All-America sweeper Paul Norman.

Last year's top three scorers are back in DAVE KOHLMEYER, team MVP BRENT DAVIS, and ROGER SWIGART. The threesome combined for 22 goals and 15 assists which was more than half of the team's output.

McGillivray says his team must still put an emphasis on scoring even with his top scorers back. The Yellow Jackets were shutout in eight of the nine losses in '88. Junior goalkeeper DAVE WEAVER returns to the nets following two years of varsity experience. He had a 1.67 goals against average last year with five shutouts.


The most depth and experience on this fall's club will be at midfield. Overall, a core of good players return, but it will take some time to fill the vacancies created by graduation.


JOHN MCGILLIVRAY Head Soccer Coach


Head Coach John McGillivray begins his 16th year at the Yellow Jacket helm with a career record of 153-110-15. He has guided Cedarville to eight Mid-Ohio Conference titles (three outright), five NCCAA Mideast district banners, three NAIA District 22 crowns, and one NAIA Area IV championship in 1974 when the Jackets placed sixth in the national tournament. He has taken four squads to the NCCAA Nationals finishing second in both 1981 and 1985. McGillivray has been honored by his peers as the NCCAA National Coach of the Year in 1981; NAIA District 22 Coach of the Year in 1974, 75, 78; and the NAIA Area IV Coach of the Year in 1974. McGillivray has been guite active within the NAIA. He is currently the District 22 soccer chairman and is a past president of the NAIA Soccer Coaches Association. John is a 1970 graduate of Cedarville College. He and his wife Bonnie reside in Cedarville and have five children.

ROGER SWIGART 5-8 160 Senior Midfield Union Grove, Wis.

A three-year letterwinner at midfield, Roger Swigart returns for his fourth season. He has started 59 of 60 games in which he has played and has been among the team's top scorers each season. Swigart was named to the All-Mid-Ohio Conference 1st team in 1987 and to the 2nd team in 1988. He is a two-time All-NAIA District 22 2nd team selection, and was picked to the NSCAA-NAIA All-Mideast 2nd team in 1987. One highlight of his career came in scoring the gamewinner of a 3-2 upset of nationally-ranked Tiffin in '87. Roger, who is regarded as one of the hardest working and most aggressive players on the field, is an American Studies major.


5-8 150 Senior Back Brookhaven, Pa.


Rod Haseltine brings experience to the back line and will be asked to provide leadership to the defense with the graduation of All-America sweeper Paul Norman. Haseltine is a three-year letterwinner and was named the Jackets' Most Valuable Defensive Player in 1988. He has started all 41 games in which he has played over the past two seasons, and last year added a goal with two assists. Rod also played centerfield for the Yellow Jacket baseball team in the spring and was the squad's leadoff hitter. Haseltine, who is a Dean's List student at Cedarville, carries a Physical Education major.

BRENT DAVIS 5-8 145 Junior Forward Manaus, Brazil

Brent Davis was tabbed Most Valuable Player of the Yellow Jackets in 1988 even though he missed three games due to injury. He was the team's second-leading scorer with 7 goals and 6 assists for 20 points in '88. He was named to the 2nd team in both the Mid-Ohio Conference and NAIA District 22, plus was an All-NCCAA District III selection. Davis is regarded as Cedarville's offensive catalyst and is the best ballhandler on the club. Brent, who was born and raised in Brazil where his parents are missionaries, is a Physical Education major at Cedarville.

5-10 170 Junior Forward Wheaton, Ill.




