



Rev Harriman and family came out in their car all here for dinner. Rankin took Anabel down after dinner. Mr Harriman and Esdady went skating with the boys. Charles Salts and Ted Richards called in afternoon.

The Harriman children stayed with me went down in the evening. It hardly seems possible we have started out on another year. The Heronimus family at tenant house. Rankin fell on ice and wrenched his knee in lane tonight.

Helen here, I busy about work. Carl feeding and helping Clayton Forest husking. All at town in evening, I at Anabels, Clayton at town. Shepherd man here after sheep.

All at S.S. and church. Harry and Lottie came out in afternoon here for supper. Rained some.

Jan 4. Mon.

A damp foggy morning. Rankin and I took washing to town, I doing errands, Mary M. and Rankin at school. Forest husking. Clayton feeding etc. Clayton and I at town in afternoon. Clayton at train meeting. I called on Lizzie Blair & Ina. All home in evening.

Jan 5. Tues.

Children at school. Forest husking. Clayton doing chores feeding I busy about work. At town in afternoon to Mrs. Johnsons to class meeting. Don

refreshment committee, took Mrs. Hays-
man and Mrs. Buck with me. Rankin
and Clayton at town in evening. Rankin
at Scout meeting.

Wed Jan 6.

Children at school. Clayton
and I left for Springfield about ten thirty
I got a new dress. Called at Arthur's
got fern, Clayton at town to school
board meeting. Children and I at
home.

Thurs Jan 7.

Children at school. Clayton
feeding. I busy sweeping etc. To post
at Xenia. Clayton and I at town after
school. An errand Mary Margaret at
Mrs. McDonalds having dress fit. At Anabels
for supper. Rankin at home doing chores.

Fri Jan 8.

Children at school. Clayton feeding
I at town at church to class perusing
and covered dish dinner. Snowing in
morning, snowed all day hard, a heavy
snow by evening. Clayton came after
me and the children. All at home this
evening.

Sat Jan 9.

A heavy snow this morning still snowing. I didn't look for Helen but she came. Busy sweeping upstairs baking etc. Men feeding. All at town in afternoon to prefect services. Anabel came home with us. Rankin at Basket Ball game.

Sat Jan 10.

Started for S. S. but car didn't go right didn't get gasolin right, so Ralph Hiramus took us down. We had communion services, and installation of Sabbath School officers. Ralph H got our car to go and came after us. All at home this afternoon. Anabel here.

Mon Jan 11.

Children at school Rankin and I at town took washing Forest and Clayton feeding, snowing and blowing all day. Clayton at town in afternoon to Clayton meeting. Clayton at school board meeting in evening.

Tues Jan 12. Forest and Clayton

feeding till noon children at school.
Edgar Little called. Busy about work.
Clayton and Rankin started to go to
scout meeting but couldn't get car to
start.

Wed Jan 13.

Children at school. Jimmie
here trying to start car and finally
did, and for spinning hog, and here to
dinner. A deep snow and very cold.
Busy about work.

Thurs Jan 14.

Mary M at school but
got out middle of morning after finished
exams, came home on filter. Rankin
at home today didn't have to go as he
got out of exams. Black out working
in car but didn't get it started out of
time, pulled it to town. Mrs Jimmie
Herron in P. at P. to call.
The baby died of pneumonia Wednesday.

and brought Hupp home. Around home

all day. Jay out in evening about
 car, Mrs. Turner and at town to

 and Carl went to basket ball
 game at Yellow Springs and

Ralph up at Selma to see Mr Wright
about sheep. Clayton feeding. All home
rest of day.

Children at school. Beautiful
day. I rest helping with chores, though
with chores by noon. Clayton at farm
out to see Martindale, to collect for alfalfa
hay, and out to see Hugh Sumbell on
cfr trade. Rankin at scout meeting
in evening. Clayton, Mary M and I
at Uncle Silas's to call.

wed Jan 20.

I busy about work. Children at school. Clayton busy about feeding. Forrest and Ruffs husking. Clayton and Mr. Kunk at Charlestown to combination sale. at Prayer meeting in evening and at Junior Play at Upper House.

Thurs Jan 21.

I went to town before school took Mary Margaret to Mrs. MacDonalds to be fit. Then to school a raining hard in morning then sleet then started to snow about one o'clock and by night there was a heavy snow. I busy picking up the apples that were sporting Clayton skated them, and in afternoon introduced Mary Margaret's pockets. Clayton at town in evening for hard cans etc.

Fri. ^{quize} A bright cold morning & deep snow, but we decided to go on with butchering. Plunkett and man and Cross and man here helping also Forrest. Mrs. Heron ^{quize} here helping me. we killed 3 for

Clayton at town after supper.

All at S. S. and church. warmer today, bright and pretty. at United Presbyterian ^{church} in evening Anabel at Aunt Belle's this Sabbath. Meddler called Simon was very sick.

Mon Jan 25.

Rampion and I at town with washing. Word came this morning that Simon died during night so sorry we didn't get down to see

him, Forrest helping with work he went to Selma after dinner took load of corn for Kibbles and brought back a load coal. Tom also brought a load of coal for us Clayton and I at Martindale and at Xenia to call on Mrs. Simon Lebo. Mary Margaret missed her jining and we didn't know she was in town so had to go back again in evening for her.

Children at school I busy about work. Clayton busy feeding etc. Edgar Little called and brought sheep home. Forrest at Springfield Clayton and Purkin at scout meeting. Still cold.

Wed Jan 27.

Children at school. Forrest help feed till noon. Ralph took calf to town and got calf at Raymond Bulls. Harris came forest with us to Dayton, part way to Xenia the car stop didn't get gas when night, Wesley boy came along and drained some gas.
