JACKETS LOSE BAKER, BUT WIN 13th!

The Cedarville College Yellow Jackets Conference hopes received a severe jolt last Saturday night in their encounter with Mt. Vernon Nazarene when 6'2" junior forward Drew Baker was carried from the floor with a severely sprained ankle. With the ankle in a cast, Coach Don Callan is not optimistic about his early return. "This type of sprain is nearly as serious as a break, so it would be impossible to predict when Drew will be back with us."

Despite the loss of Baker, the Yellow Jackets went on to defeat Mt. Vernon 97-84 in a shoot out! 6'5" Sophomore David Carr had the best over-all performance of his career with 16 points and 16 rebounds. Mounts led the Jackets with 34 points while Mark Womack canned 18, his seasonal average. Baker had scored 12 points before his injury.

The Jackets journeyed to Walsh College in Canton, Ohio for Mid-Ohio Conference action on Tuesday, January 13 and came away with a hard fought 76-73 victory which was still in doubt until 5'11" guard Curt Berger sank two free throws with two seconds on the clock. The physical contest, which at times resembled a football game, or war, saw the Jackets convert 28 of 34 free throws for 82.4%. Both Carr and Pryor, 6'7" reserve center fouled out of the contest. Mounts, who sat out some

of the first half with three fouls, still managed 25 points. Both Tim Danube, 6'6" freshman forward and 6'0 Malcolm Dixon, guard played well in reserve roles. Curt Berger scored 12 points even though missing five minutes of the contest because of a foot injury.

The Jackets remain the only undefeated team in the Mid-Ohio Conference (4-0) and have a 13-1 over-all record. Interesting individual statistics include the following:

1. Eric Mounts leading the Conference in scoring (28.1 p.p.g.ave.)
2. Mark Womack 4th in Conference scoring (17.6 p.p.g.ave.)
3. Mark Womack is 21 for 22 in free throws through 14 games (95.4%)!!

The Jackets visit a strong Urbana team Saturday night, January 17 that is fresh from a 91-90 victory over the Malone College Pioneers.
