## *Rio Falls to Yellow Jackets Team Play*

Last night the Cedarville College Yellow Jackets came home with what head coach, Dr. Don Callan, terms "the most exciting win of the year." In the outing against the Rio Grande Redmen, the Jackets rallied from a 75-67 deficit with 3:48 left to tie at 81-81 following a jumper by Mark Womack.

In the overtime situation, Tom Jutze missed the front end of a one and one with eight seconds left. Eric Mounts pulled down the rebound, dribbled past mid-court and passed to Womack who scored the winning basket with no time on the clock as Cedarville edged Rio Grande 91-90.

The Yellow Jackets barely escaped "the dull drums." After having already secured the number one position in the NAIA District 22 playoffs, the Mid-Ohio Conference tournament, and earned the league championship, it's not the kind of game you rally around. "But our kids play to win," commented Dr. Callan. "It is times like these I'm thankful for a strong bench. They sit all year and come off the bench like gang busters to do the job. It was definitely a reserve win."

That's not to down play the excellent performance of "Cool Hands" Womack who led all scorers with 26 points, aided by 20 points from All-American, Eric Mounts and Greg Greve's 14 point effort.
