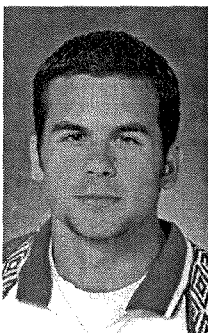
Today's Match

Cedarville College is in its 37th year of men's soccer and today the Jackets open their newest and what they believe to be the best home site they've ever had. This is the sixth home field the Yellow Jackets have utilized and it was designed and built under the direction of athletic director, Pete Reese. It's a good year for such an occasion. Cedarville, 9-5 overall with a 4-4 AMC mark, has already surpassed last year's overall win total (8) and AMC victory total (3).

It has been a struggle this year for Shawnee State, who enters the match 2-13 overall and winless in eight AMC matches. However, the Bears are coming off a 3-1 victory over Appalachian Bible College in their last outing on Wednesday.

Junior midfielder Aaron Cook leads Cedarville in scoring with seven goals and two assists for 16 points. Dave Anthony has four goals and three assists for 11 points while Roddy Willis has five goals and an assist for 11 points. Freshman goalkeeper Matt Reid has a 1.82 goals against average.

Aaron Cook, a junior from Borden, IN, had a notable sophomore season in which he led the Yellow Jackets in scoring and was named to the NCCAA All-America Second Team....Ranked ninth in the American Mideast Conference with nine goals and eight assists for 26 points.....Selected to the NCCAA Midwest Region First Team and was AMC Honorable Mention.....Played in all 22 matches with 21

starts.....Totalled two goals and two assists in a 6-0 win versus Shawnee State.....Had a goal and an assist in 2-1 upset of Walsh.....Appeared in 13 matches, all coming off the bench, as a rookie in 1997 with one assist....Four-year letter winner and MVP in soccer at Graceland Christian High School where he played for his father....Played for two-time Kentucky state champion Louisville Soccer Club....Psychology major at Cedarville College....Born 11/21/78....Son of Rev. and Mrs. Tom Cook....Has one younger brother and younger twin sisters.
