Today's Match

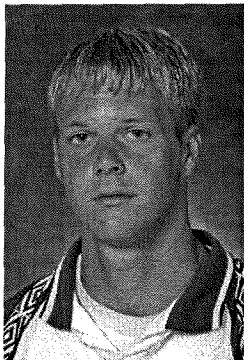
The Yellow Jackets open the home portion of the schedule this afternoon against American Mideast Conference foe Malone College. It's the 36th meeting between the two schools with Cedarville holding a 19-12-4 advantage.

The Jackets opened the season with their best start in school history by winning their first five matches. The 1976 and 1986 clubs both went 4-0-0 to start. Since then, Cedarville has lost back-to-back matches to unbeaten teams. They dropped a 3-0 decision at Otterbein and a 3-1 AMC contest at Point Park on Saturday.

Junior midfielder Aaron Cook leads Cedarville in scoring with 5 goals and 1 assist for 11 points. Dave Anthony and Justin Geer have netted three goals each. Rookie goalkeeper Matt Reid has a 1.36 goals against average.

Today is the AMC opener for Malone. The Pioneers have not played since a 2-2 tie at Lake Erie last Tuesday. Senior midfielder Chris Huff leads the team in scoring with 4 goals and 1 assist for 9 points.
