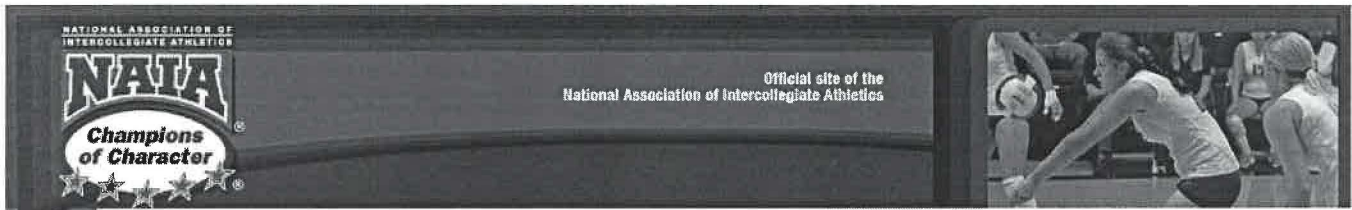

Maija Hampton Named NAIA Volleyball Player of the Week

Hampton averaged 4.33 kills and 3.33 digs

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – Maija Hampton of Cedarville (Ohio) has been selected as the NAIA Volleyball Player of the Week for the week ending Sunday, Oct. 5, 2008.

Hampton, a senior outside hitter from Cincinnati, Ohio, averaged 4.33 kills and 3.33 digs in three wins for the Yellow Jackets last week. She recorded two double-doubles during the week including a career-high 27 kills and 14 digs against previously unbeaten Shawnee State (Ohio). Hampton also added 14 kills and 19 digs against No. 25 Walsh (Ohio) and 11 kills against Urbana (Ohio).
