Today's Match

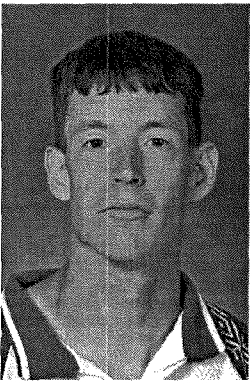
The Yellow Jackets play seven of their last nine matches of the season on the home turf beginning this afternoon with longtime rival Mount Vernon Nazarene. Cedarville is 6-3 overall and 2-2 in the league while MVNC has a record of 8-2 and 1-1.

Junior midfielder Aaron Cook leads Cedarville in scoring with 6 goals and 2 assists for 14 points. Justin Geer has 4 goals and an assist for 9 points while Dave Anthony has 3 goals and 2 assists for 8 points. Rookie goalkeeper Matt Reid has a 1.44 goals against average.

Mount Vernon Nazarene junior Josh Robson leads the AMC in goals scored with 12 and in overall scoring with 6 assists and 30 points total. Classmate Rick Collins paces the league in assists with 8.

Cedarville is coming off of a 2-1 overtime win at Geneva on Saturday. Aaron Cook got the Jackets on the board first and Roddy Willis netted the game winner 10 minutes into OT.

Mike Moran is one of the team's co-captains for the 1999 season which is his third year in the program.....Has played in every match during his two-year Yellow Jacket career and is the only returning player to have started all 22 matches last fall.....Tallied one goal and one assist from his defensive position.....Was a welcome addition to the Yellow Jacket defense in 1997 upon transferring from Oakland Community College in

Michigan.....One of five players to play in all 16 matches during his initial season with 11 starting assignments.....Played just one season of junior varsity soccer as a freshman at Plymouth MI Salem High School and did not resume playing until reaching the college level.....Dean's List student as a Physical Education major at Cedarville College who intends on becoming a teacher.....Born 12/17/75.....Son of Mr. Marv Moran and Mrs. Mary Ruth Satterthwaite.....Has one older brother and one younger brother.
