GTE/COSIDA Academic All-America Nomination Form At-Large (Men's and Women's)

Your district coordinator must receive this typed, completed nomination form by May 11 via the mail. To be nominated, the athlete must be a starter or important reserve with at least a 3.20 cumulative grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) for his/her career. No athlete is eligible until he/she has reached sophomore athletic and academic standing at his/her current institution (thus, true freshmen, red-shirt freshmen and first-year transfers are not eligible).

The institution is limited to a maximum of three men's nominees and a maximum of three women's nominees. No institution may nominate more than two athletes per sport for men or women.
