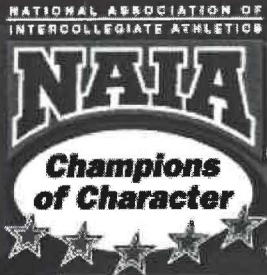

Sarah Zeltman of [Cedarville University \(Ohio\)](#), **Renee Faimon** of [Hastings College \(Neb.\)](#), and **Amanda Bowling** of [Union College \(Ky.\)](#), were selected as Volleyball National Player, Libero, and Setter of the Week, respectively

Zeltman, a junior Middle Hitter from Kidron, Ohio, led Cedarville to a upset victory over #5 Madonna University, snapping their 73-match regular season home winning streak, and also helped the Lady Jackets win the Madonna Invitational. For the week, she had 63 kills and a Total Kill percentage of .427. She was also named to the all-tournament team and was named MVP.

Faimon, a senior defensive specialist from Lawrence, Nebraska, led Hastings to a 3-1 upset victory over #12 Doane College, when she broke a school record for digs in a game with 46.

Bowling, a senior from Louisville, Kentucky, posted a triple-double in a win against Bluefield (Va.) with 10 kills, 43 assists and 10 digs. She averaged 11.15 assists for the week.
