LAST TIME OUT:

Unbeaten Findlay handed the Yellow Jackets their first loss of the season with a 2-1 victory in Cedarville's home opener on Monday. The Oilers, 4-0-2 overall, broke a scoreless tie with a goal in the 59th minute and then received a break by converting a penalty kick eight minutes later. The Jackets got on the board in the 86th minute when Peter Dryer scored his first goal of the season with Tyler Schumacher assisting. Findlay held a 17-6 shot advantage with an 11-3 edge in the second half alone.

The Cedarville University men's soccer team begins AMC South Division action this afternoon when they host the Shawnee State University Bears. Despite not playing a game last week, Cedarville moved up three spots to No. 16 in the NAIA Top 25. The Yellow Jackets enter the match with a 7-1 record after having their season-opening winning streak stopped by the University of Findlay, 2-1, on Monday. Shawnee State is 0-2 having dropped matches to Ohio Dominican and Capital University. The Yellow Jackets hold an 8-2-1 edge in the all-time series with the Bears. Cedarville blitzed Shawnee State 9-1 in last season's only meeting.

Shawnee State returns just five sophomores and five juniors from last year's squad with ten freshmen and three transfers added to the 2002 roster. The top returning players for the Bears are Jeremiah Roediger, B.J. Lyon, and Robert Appell. Roediger earned All-AMC Honorable Mention last season while Lyon is a two-year starter and returning captain. Appell has started in goal for the Bears the last two seasons.

Cedarville will attempt to recover from their first loss of the season as they begin AMC action. Junior forward Jon Waldo and freshman forward Phil Ellis have accounted for 11 of the team's 17 goals while assisting on six

of the tallies. Cedarville still holds a commanding 124-74 lead over their opponents in shots on goal.

Senior keeper Matt Reid has posted 33 saves while allowing 7 goals with two shutouts in the first eight matches.
