Fresno Pacific (Calif.) Stays No. 1 in Tachikara-NAIA Volleyball Coaches' Top 25 Poll

Top eight spots unchanged

Oct. 21, 2008

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – For the seventh straight week Fresno Pacific (Calif.) was a unanimous choice for the top spot in the Tachikara-NAIA Volleyball Coaches' Top 25 Poll. The Sunbirds received all 26 first place votes and 746 total points.

The next seven spots also remained the same. Concordia (Calif.) stayed in the second position with 722 points while Biola (Calif.) remained at No. 3 with 698 points and No. 4 California Baptist (668 points) and No. 5 Bellevue (Neb.) (654 points) held their spots. Columbia (Mo.), Madonna (Mich.) and Lindenwood (Mo.) also held their spots at No. 6, No. 7 and No. 8 with 618, 599 and 579 points respectively. Azusa Pacific (Calif.) and Georgetown (Ky.) each moved up a spot from last week to No. 9 and No. 10 to round the top-10. APU received 544 points while Georgetown earned 538 points.

College of Idaho moved into the top-25 for the first time since preseason poll at No. 22.

The eighth regular season top 25 poll will be released on Tuesday, Oct. 28th.

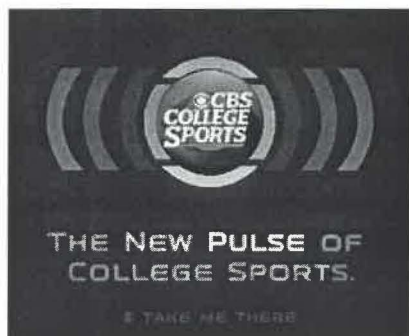
