1989 Season Prospectus & Coaches

The 1989 version of the Heidelberg track and field team has the potential to be the best in school history, and Head Coach John Kernan is well aware of it.

"I feel that we have assembled the best team that Heidelberg College has ever had the privilege of having. This



group of young men and women have the opportunity to make history and I believe that they will do that."

The men will be led by three-year letterwinner and two-time All-Ohio Athletic Conference performer Casio Vargas. Other top performers for the men should include; top notch distance runner, junior, Stu Behm, senior All-OAC shot putter and discus thrower Kyle Barlow, sophomore Jason Brown, an All-OAC performer in sprints, hurdles and relays, NCAA pole vault qualifier, junior John Rhoades, sophomore All-OAC javelin thrower Dave Mayer and junior Duff Taylor who has twice been All-OAC and is the school record holder in the 500 meters.



Kernan will also be counting on contributions from some newcomers. Among those expected to step in and make immediate impact are Mark Wagner (freshman from Sycamore), Criss Maple (freshman from Toronto), Bill Butcher (sophomore from Beloit) and Rick Jones (freshman from Buckeye Lake).

The women's team appears to have rebounded from the heavy graduation losses of two seasons ago. Lynne Poland (sophomore from Monclova) and Barb Moore (sophomore from Perry), an All-OAC performer and Heidelberg women's record holder in the shot put, will lead a balanced and talented women's squad in 1989. Looking to aid Poland and Moore will be junior Trina Horton (Columbus) and sophomore Kris Moats (Circleville). Both were members of the 4 x 400 relay team that set the Heidelberg record of 4:17.9 last season.

With only a single senior on the squad, and only a handful of performers with a great deal of experience, Coach Kernan will lean heavily on his newcomers and freshmen.

Slated to step in and contribute to the Lady Student Princes' cause are; freshmen Becky Banhagel (sprints, relays and long jump), Colette DeWolf (400 & 800 meters), Ameer McCool (1500 meters, 3000 meters and relays), Liz Wrocklage (intermediate hurdles, sprints and relays), Vicki Lucas (shot put) and Brenda Weaver (sprints and relays).

Coach Kernan feels that he has just the right mix of experience and youth, and that the right combinations will open the lock to an Ohio Athletic Conference Championship.

In his fourth season at the helm of the Heidelberg track & field teams, Dr. John Kernan has built one of the most respected programs in the Ohio Athletic Conference.

Prior to coming to Heidelberg in 1986, Kernan spent nine years at Kansas Wesleyan University, guiding his teams to the only two cross country conference titles in school history. During those years, his men's and women's cross country and track athletes won 14 collegiate All-American awards and 31 individual Kansas Conference championships. Before his stint at KWU, Kernan served as an assistant coach at Baylor and at BYU, where he

worked with three Olympic athletes. In addition to his participation in the Athletics Congress Level II Coaching Certification School at the U.S. Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, Colorado, the U.S. State Department sent Dr. Kernan to West Africa to assist Ghana in their track and field coaching school in 1984.

During his time at Heidelberg, the Student Princes have had one All-American, sent four athletes to the NCAA Nationals, crowned 10 OAC individual champions and earned 44 All-OAC certificates in individual and relay events.
