### NEW DELIVERY SERVICE

On January 3rd, the Library began participation in the OhioLINK Ground Delivery Service run by Pony Express. This service includes daily pick-up from and delivery to over 40 colleges and universities in Ohio for interlibrary loan and media services materials. We are participating under the auspices of the Southwestern Ohio Council for Higher Education, all of whose member institutions are on the delivery service. SOCHE is the only consortium outside of the OhioLINK group currently participating in this new service. This broadened delivery capability should improve turn-around time for providing interlibrary loan resources for students and faculty.
