## 1988 SEASON OUTLOOK

John McGillivray begins his 15th year as head coach with a number of veteran players returning to this fall's edition of Cedarville College soccer. The Yellow Jackets have eight starters coming back from last year's 11-9-1 team that was a tri-champion of the Mid-Ohio Conference and NCCAA Mideast District runner-up.

"This is as much experience as I have had coming back than at any other time in recent years," reported McGillivray. "We expect to be strong defensively while our ability to score consistently may be a question mark."

Leading the defense will be two-time NCCAA 2nd team All-American Paul Norman. He was moved to the back at mid-season last fall from his forward position and he played so well that the NSCAA recognized him as a 2nd team NAIA All-American. Another senior on the back line will be honorable mention all-district performer Andy Lewis.

Minding the nets will be 6-4 sophomore Dave Weaver. He logged better than 1500 minutes last year with an 8-7-1 record and 1.32 goals against average.

Junior Roger Swigart will be roaming the midfield once again. Swigart is recognized as the catalyst in the middle for the Jackets where last year he gained post-season honors from the NAIA, NCCAA, MOC, and NSCAA.

McGillivray calls sophomore Brent Davis one of his top three players. The 5-8 forward from Brazil will be joined up front by last year's two leading scorers. Senior Derek Whalen and sophomore Dave Kohlmeyer both notched 8 goals and 3 assists last fall for 19 points apiece.

"I believe we'll receive excellent leadership from our seniors," said McGillivray. "After losing the NCCAA district final last year (1-0 at Spring Arbor), they will be determined to win it this season."

McGillivray called the schedule comorable to last year, though it only contains 15 games. The Yellow Jackets open the season with a night game at Ohio Wesleyan on Sept. 13, one of the premiere NCAA Div. III programs in the country. Two more night games in October will be at NAIA District 22 champion Wilmington and at IUPUI-Indianapolis. Cedarville will have seven home games highlighted by the Oct. 15 homecoming match with Siena Heights College.

**JOHN MCGILLIVRAY**  
Head Soccer Coach

Head Coach John McGillivray begins his 15th year at the Yellow Jacket helm with a career record of 142-101-14. He has guided Cedarville to eight Mid-Ohio Conference titles (three outright), four NCCAA Mideast district banners, three NAIA District 22 crowns, and one NAIA Area IV championship in 1974 when the Jackets placed sixth in the national tournament. He has taken three squads to the NCCAA Nationals finishing second in both 1981 and 1985. McGillivray has been honored by his peers as the NCCAA National Coach of the Year in 1981; NAIA District 22 Coach of the Year in 1974, 75, 78; and the NAIA Area IV Coach of the Year in 1974. John is a 1970 graduate of Cedarville College. He and his wife Bonnie reside in Cedarville and have five children.

**PAUL NORMAN**  
6-1 170 SR B Millersville, Maryland

Paul Norman returns in 1988 after turning in a fine season last fall after which he was named the team's MVP. He was switched from his familiar forward spot to the back position at mid-season and still managed to rank third on the club in scoring with 6 goals and 3 assists for 15 points. Paul was named a 2nd Team NCCAA All-American for the second straight year, plus he was tabbed to the NSCAA All-America 2nd Team for the NAIA Division. Norman earned 1st team honors in NAIA District 22, NCCAA Mideast, Mid-Ohio Conference, NSCAA All-Mideast, and NSCAA All-Ohio.



**ROGER SWIGART**  
5-8 160 JR MF Union Grove, Wisconsin

Roger Swigart is regarded as one of the most aggressive and hardest working players that McGillivray has. Roger's highlight of 1987 came when he scored the winning goal in the Yellow Jackets' 3-2 upset of Tiffin University, then ranked 8th in the NAIA. Swigart was fifth on the club in scoring with 5 goals and 4 assists for 14 points. He was named 1st Team in both the Mid-Ohio Conference and NCCAA Mideast District, 2nd team in NAIA District 22 and NSCAA All-Mideast, and 3rd team NSCAA All-Ohio.

**DEREK WHALEN**  
6-0 145 SR F Royersford, Pennsylvania

Derek Whalen tied for the team scoring lead last fall with 8 goals and 3 assists for 19 points. He was named 2nd Team Mid-Ohio Conference and also garnered NAIA District 22 honorable mention honors. Derek, along with Paul Norman, was a member of Cedarville's 1985 NCCAA national runner-up team.
