White Contributes to “Nelson Annual Preacher’s Sourcebook”

CEDARVILLE, OHIO – The fourth volume of “Nelson Annual Preacher’s Sourcebook,” a guide for pastors with sermon starters, outlines and ideas for worship, has been published with sermons from Thomas White, president of Cedarville University and third-generation preacher. White’s contribution of sermons to this volume highlights his passion for both preaching and the local church. The publication will be released November 11.

“I am constantly amazed by the greatness of God. Throughout the Bible, His providential plan shows up over and over,” said White. “These sermons highlight that the God we serve has demonstrated Himself as the omnipotent God of the universe who controls everything, and yet a gracious God who knows each of us and demonstrated His love in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. We serve a God bigger than all of our problems, and our responsibility is to tell others about His gracious Gospel.”

In his introduction to the volume, O.S. Hawkins, editor of the series, notes that the “sourcebook is designed to lie alongside” the pastor’s “tools of word studies, exegesis, commentaries, analytical thought, and prayer that goes into the fully developed, prayed-over, and well-crafted sermon.” Other contributors to this year’s Sourcebook include pastors Mac Brunson, Ronnie Floyd, Robert Jeffress, Erwin W. Lutzer and Dr. R. Albert Mohler Jr., president of The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary.
