#### OHIOLINK COMING SOON

The schedule is in place for the Centennial Library to be operational with OhioLINK (Ohio Library and Information Network) by early September, 1996. The installation of the OhioLINK version of the Library's automated system software will begin in mid-June. Loading of the data from the Centennial Library catalog to the central catalog at Wright State University will begin about July 1 with completion by mid-July. After a testing period and orientation of Centennial Library staff to the changes that will need to be implemented, it is anticipated that direct borrowing through the OhioLINK system will be available to faculty and staff by September 1. OhioLINK is a statewide library resource sharing network of over 40 state and private colleges and universities with a common on-line catalog of over 5,000,000 volumes, on-line direct borrowing, shared electronic databases, and a daily delivery service. Faculty in-service sessions on OhioLINK features and use are being planned for the Fall.

## NEW LIBRARY HOME PAGE ON THE WORLD WIDE WEB

A new Library Home Page is now accessible from the College Home Page. The newest version, entitled CedarLINK (Cedarville College Library Information Network), was redesigned, built, and loaded under the direction of a Library task team. The Task Team was under the direction of Jan Bosma and included Lynne Funtik, Melody Curtis, Steve Brock, and Mark Mazelin from Computer Services. The Library home page is the "window" to the description of all Library services and policies, electronic resources, the library catalog and other library catalogs, and selected INTERNET resources. To access the CedarLINK home page, select "College Departments" from the College home page, then from "Other Departments," select the "Centennial Library." For quick access, create a Bookmark from the College home page to CedarLINK.

## NEW COLOR COPIER SERVICE

In late May, color copier capability was added to the services of the Media Resource Center with the installation of an HP color copier. The first color copy of any original costs \$0.75 with each subsequent print of that same original costing \$0.50. Copy quality is excellent.

## SUMMER AT THE LIBRARY

The public hours for the Library for the Summer of 1996 are listed both on the Library Information screens found on the Library Catalog main menu and by access through the Library Home Page. The Library Home Page can be access as directed in the item above. Printed copies are available at the Circulation Desk. The Curriculum Materials Center, the Media Resource Center, and AV Services will be available during all the Library summer hours. For those faculty intending to use media hardware and software during the summer sessions, please contact AV Services at 7853 for assistance in scheduling as you would during the other academic quarters.

#### STAFF NEWS

At a May 19th luncheon for all Library staff and families, Library student assistants were honored for their contribution to the Library operation. Each year, Library student assistants work over 12,000 hours in the various Library departments. In fact, over 40% of the Library's open hours of service are under the direction or supervision of student library assistants. This year 11 seniors were honored for their service to the Library.

## CENTENNIAL LIBRARY HOSTS NATIONAL CONFERENCE

For the second time in the 1990's, Cedarville College and the Centennial Library Staff will be hosting an annual conference of the Association of Christian Librarians on June 18-21. The theme for the 40th annual conference of the Association is "Confronting Emerging Realities: Information Technology in the Academic Library." Conference sessions will address broad issues in information technology, the analysis of specific technologies, the impact on library staff and operations, and the realities of operating in the technological environment. Featured speakers will be Thomas G. Kirk, College Librarian at Earlham College in Richmond, Indiana; Tom Sanville, Executive Director of OhioLINK, Dr. Richard Pettitt, a Cedarville College graduate, who is Assistant University Librarian at Miami University in Oxford, Ohio; and Dave Rotman, Director of Computer Services here at Cedarville. Approximately 30 workshops will also be offered. Currently over 225 registrants and participants will be in attendance. McChesney and McKinney Halls will house most of the registrants; meetings and activities will take place in the Library and the ENS Building with the general sessions in ENS 245.
