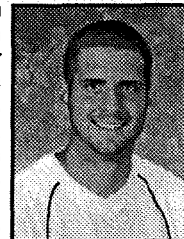
Tonight's Match



The Cedarville University men's soccer team hosts the Georgetown College Tigers in non-conference action tonight at Yellow Jacket Field.

The Yellow Jackets enter tonight's contest with a 11-4-2 mark including a 5-3 record in the AMC South Division. Cedarville lost a 1-0 battle at Tiffin University this past Saturday.

Senior forward Jon Waldo has taken over the team lead in scoring for the Yellow Jackets with seven goals and four assists for 18 points. Junior midfielder Peter Dryer has posted seven goals and two assists for 16 points while freshman Stephen Brust has added six goals and four assists for 16 points. Sophomore Grant Knight has contributed five goals and three assists to the Yellow Jacket attack for 13 points. Sophomore forward Alex Benedict has found the net three times for the Yellow Jackets. Junior Joe Zuerner has registered 3 assists while sophomore Tyler Schumacher has recorded four goals. Cedarville is outscoring their opponents by a 37-22 margin. Senior keeper Joel Reemtsma and junior goalie Casey Sullivan have combined to allow 1.25 goals per game. Reemtsma has three shutouts to his credit while Sullivan has recorded two.

Georgetown College, an NAIA member of the Mid-South Conference, enters tonight's contest with a 7-7-1 record. In their most recent action, the Tigers battled Spalding (KY) to a 2-2 double overtime deadlock. Georgetown is 1-3-0 and in fourth place in the Mid-South Conference. The Tigers are scoring 2.13 goals per game while allowing 2.27 goals per contest. Sophomore forward Josh Rogers leads the squad with 16 goals and ranks third in the conference with 35 points. Senior keeper Aaron Frey ranks fourth in the Mid-South with a 2.27 goals against average.

The only previous meeting between the schools resulted in a 2-1 victory in Kentucky for the Yellow Jackets in the season-opening match of the 2002 campaign.

Last Time Out



NAIA No. 20 Tiffin scored in the 78th minute for a 1-0 victory over Cedarville in American Midwest Conference South Division play. It marked the fifth time this season the Yellow Jackets have been blanked and it's their second 1-0 setback.

Tiffin had a decisive 17-8 edge in shots for the match. The Dragons placed eight shots on goal and limited CU to just one.

Cedarville hosts the defending NAIA national champion University of Mobile (AL) on Saturday, Nov. 1 at 5:00 pm. in the final regular season match of the 2003 campaign. The Yellow Jackets will await word about NAIA and NCCAA post-season competition. The top four teams in each division of the AMC will participate in the AMC Qualifying Tournament with opponents and sites to be determined by final standings.

#17 Todd Beall

6-2, 170, Senior, Defender, Annandale, VA

Todd Beall is back for his third season with the Yellow Jackets and will serve as a team captain.....returned to the roster last fall after missing the entire 2001 season with an injury.....started all 19 matches in which he played.....his lone assist of the season set up Jon Waldo's overtime goal in a 3-2 win at Wittenberg.....part of a CU defense that posted eight shutouts while allowing 25 goals in 20 games.

2000 - Stepped right into the CU starting defensive line-up as a freshman.....played in 19 of the 20 matches with 18 starts.

High School - Played four seasons of soccer at Paul VI High School.....earned three letters and was named defensive Player of the Year as a senior.....participated in track & field one season and earned a letter.

Personal - Carries a sport management major at Cedarville University.....born 2/20/82 in Newport, RI.....son of Mr. and Mrs. Bradley Beall.....has one older brother.



#9 Jon Waldo

6-2, 170, Senior, Defender, Annandale, VA

Jon Waldo is one of the most prolific scorers in Yellow Jacket soccer history.....enters his final season fourth all-time at CU in scoring (122 points), fourth in goals scored(48), and second in assists (26)....needs just two assists to become the school's all-time assist leader and only nine points to move into 2nd place behind all-time scoring leader and NAIA Hall of Famer Larry Bollback (189 points).....led the 2002 club in scoring for the

third straight year with 16 goals and 7 assists for 39 points.....netted at least two goals in a match five times including a three-goal effort in a 4-0 win at Taylor.....scored the game winner in a 3-2 overtime victory at Wittenberg and assisted on the team's other two goals.....tallied two goals and three assists in a 7-0 AMC decision over Shawnee State.... earned spots on the NAIA Region IX Team, NCCAA Midwest Region First Team, and the AMC South Division First Team.

2001 - Started all 24 matches as a sophomore and exploded for 21 goals and a school-record 14 assists for 56 points.....point total was the third-highest in school history for a season and his goal output was the fifth best.....registered six multi-goal games including four three-goal efforts.....tallied two or more assists four times.....scored overtime goals against AMC foes Malone and Tiffin, and assisted on another versus Grace.....named to the NCCAA National All-Tournament Team and to the NCCAA Midwest Region First Team.....voted to the American Mideast Conference Second Team.

2000 - Made an immediate contribution as a freshman by leading the team in scoring with 11 goals and 5 assists for 27 points.....made his collegiate debut with two goals, including the game winner in overtime, during a 3-2 victory against Northland Baptist.....scored three times versus Defiance.....named to the NCCAA All-America Second Team and to the NCCAA Midwest Region First Team.

High School - Produced a record-setting career at Riverside Brookfield High School.....started all 75 matches during his prep career finishing with school records of 65 goals and 54 assists for 185 points.....graduated 7th all-time in the state of Illinois in assists and 50th in goals scored.....owns the fastest goal in state history (0:07) and his five assists in one match rates third all-time.....also scored five goals in a match.....finished 4th in the state in scoring as a senior with 31 goals and 23 assists for 85 points.....four-time team MVP and four-time All-Suburban Prairie Conference player.....league MVP as a senior and was a two-time Academic All-State selection.....earned two letters in track & field.....National Honor Society student.

Personal - Carries a finance major at Cedarville Universityborn 4/5/82 in Crown Point, IN.....son of Rev. and Mrs. Tom Waldo.....older brother, James, is a 2002 Cedarville graduate.....has one younger sister.
