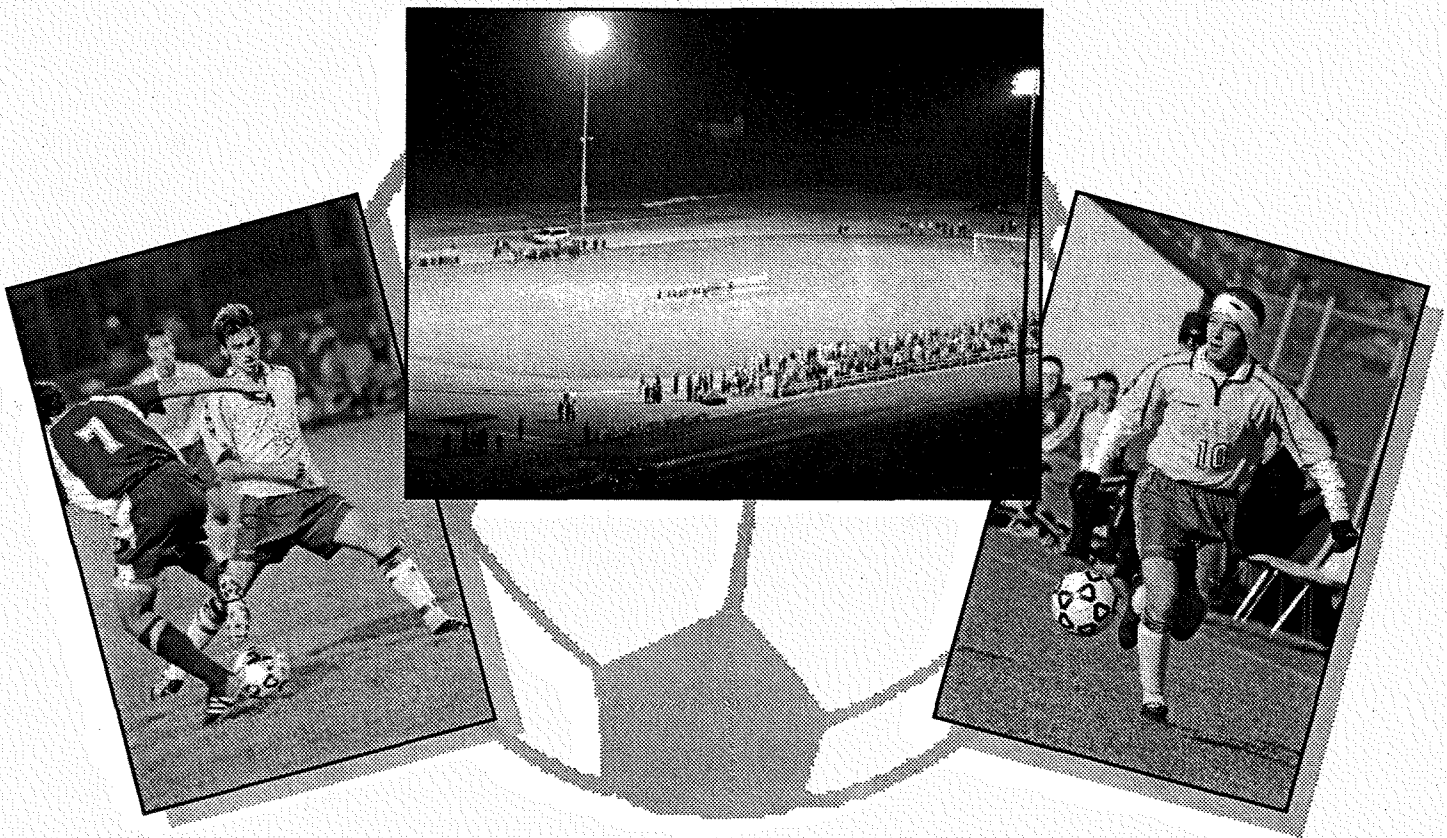

Tonight's Match



The Cedarville University men's soccer team hosts the Mount Vernon Nazarene Cougars in American Midwest Conference South Division action at Yellow Jacket Field.

The Yellow Jackets enter tonight's contest with a 10-3-2 mark including a 4-2 record in the AMC South Division. Cedarville defeated Indiana Wesleyan 3-0 in non-conference action this past Saturday.

Junior midfielder Peter Dryer leads the Yellow Jackets with seven goals and two assists for 16 points. Senior forward Jon Waldo has posted 6 goals and three assists for 15 points. Freshman Stephen Brust has added five goals and three assists for 13 points. Sophomore Grant Knight has contributed five goals to the Yellow Jacket attack. Cedarville is outscoring their opponents by a 33-20 margin. Junior Joe Zuerner has registered 3 assists while sophomore John Sommer had also recorded 3 assists before suffering a torn ACL to end his season. Senior keeper Joel Reemtsma and junior goalie Casey Sullivan have combined to allow 1.29 goals per game. Reemtsma has three shutouts to his credit while Sullivan has recorded two.

Mount Vernon Nazarene, ranked fifth in the NAIA Region IX, enters tonight's contest with a 10-3-1 overall record including a 2-2-1 mark in the AMC South Division. The Cougars posted a 3-2 win against Malone College last Tuesday night. Mount Vernon has three regular season contests remaining after tonight including AMC South Division matches at Shawnee State and home with Walsh University.



Freshman forward Stephen Brust has 5 goals and 3 assists.

The Cougars are led on offense by junior forward Nate Sommers who ranks tenth in the AMC in points per game (1.91) on 9 goals and 3 assists. Steve Lesmes, a freshman forward, has 8 goals and 3 assists for 19 points. Freshman keeper Jordan Knight has allowed 14 goals in 11 contests to rank seventh in the AMC with a 1.26 gaa.

Cedarville leads the all-time series with a 20-8-1 record. The Yellow Jackets have outscored the Cougars 76-37 in the series which began in 1978. The Yellow Jackets posted a 1-0 shutout win at Mount Vernon in the fourth match of the 2002 season.

Last Time Out



Jon Waldo had a goal and an assist as the Yellow Jackets did all of their scoring in the first half of a 3-0 non-conference victory over Indiana Wesleyan on Saturday evening. Joel Reemtsma made two saves in goal and recorded his third shutout.

Waldo scooped up a loose ball and passed to a wide open Stephen Brust, who tucked in his fifth goal of the season in the 19th minute to get the scoring underway. Waldo picked off an errant pass and blasted home his sixth goal unassisted in the 25th minute. Peter Dryer completed the scoring with an unassisted goal in the 35th minute which was his team-high seventh tally of the year.

Joel Reemtsma is a four-year player with the Yellow Jackets, who has the opportunity to see a wealth of time this fall in goal.....played last year in a 4-0 non-conference win at Taylor.....also appeared in AMC victories over Shawnee State and Ohio Dominican.....NCCAA All-America Scholar-Athlete.

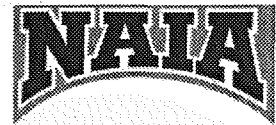
