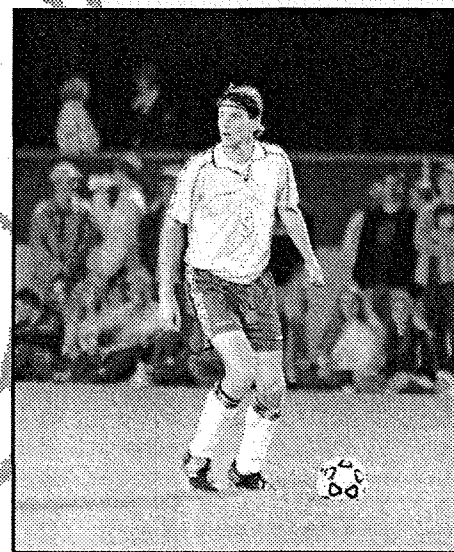
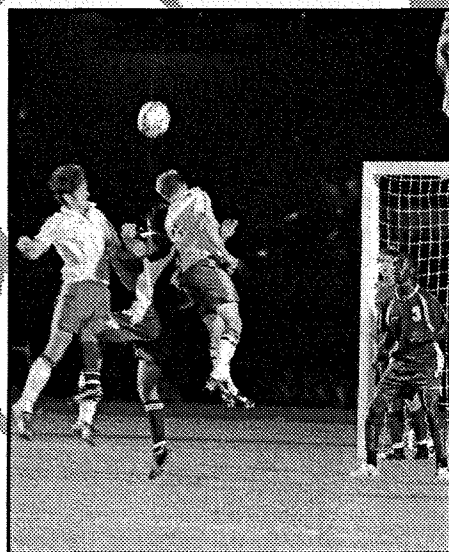
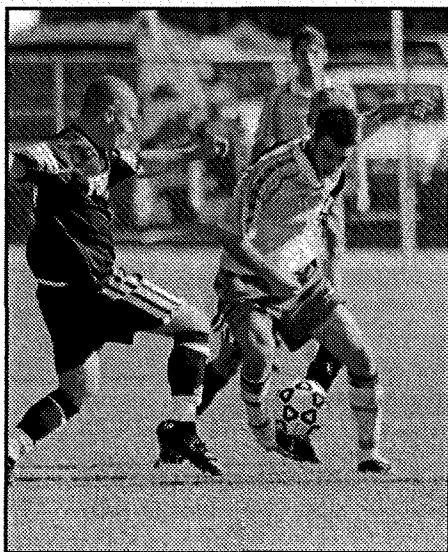

## Tonight's Match

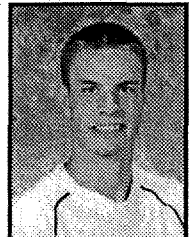


The Cedarville University men's soccer team hosts the University of Rio Grande tonight in an early-season American Mideast Conference South Division marquee matchup at Yellow Jacket Field.

The Yellow Jackets enter tonight's contest with a 7-1-2 mark including a 2-0 record in the AMC South Division. Cedarville rolled to an 8-0 victory at Shawnee State on Saturday after suffering their first defeat of the season, a 2-0 loss at Bethel (IN) on Friday.

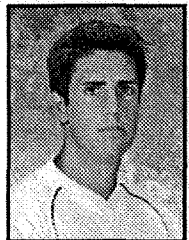
The University of Rio Grande, ranked #1 in the NAIA, is 9-0 overall and has allowed just one goal the entire season. This will be their first AMC South Division contest of the season. The Redmen outlasted the University of Charleston (WV), 2-0, this past Saturday night.

Senior forward Jon Waldo leads the Yellow Jackets with 5 goals and an assist for 11 points. Junior midfielder Peter Dryer and freshman forward Stephen Brust have each contributed 4 goals and 2 assists for 10 points. Sophomores Grant Knight and Tyler Schumacher have each added three goals to the Yellow Jacket attack. Cedarville has outscored their opponents by a 25-10 margin in the first ten games of the campaign. Senior keeper Joel Reemtsma and junior keeper Casey Sullivan have combined to allow just .95 goals per game. Sullivan has two shutouts while Reemtsma has posted one.

The Redmen are led by Ben Hunter, a freshman forward has registered 11 goals and 1 assist, and junior forward Simon Carey with 9 goals and 3 assists. Sophomores Ben Callon and John Carroll lead Rio Grande with 5 assists each. Senior keeper Oliver Sanders has registered an incredible 8 shutouts on the season. Rio's talented roster includes just five seniors.

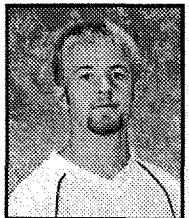
Rio Grande leads the all-time series - which began in 1984 - with the Yellow Jackets by a 12-7-1 margin including a 3-1 win in the NAIA Region IX Final Four last season. The Redmen have scored 50 goals in the series while the Yellow Jackets have registered 38. Rio Grande captured last year's Region IX championship and finished in the Elite Eight at the 2002 NAIA Nationals.

## Last Time Out



Less than 24 hours after suffering their first loss of the season, the Yellow Jackets bounced back to overwhelm host Shawnee St., 8-0 in American Mideast Conference South Division play. Cedarville had eight separate players score while outshooting the Bears by a 34-2 margin.

The Jackets started slowly and finally got on the board in the 34th minute when Andrew Belleman scored on an assist from Jon Taylor. Jason Auyer made it 2-0 just two minutes later with Stephen Brust and Joe Zuerner assisting.

Cedarville blew the contest open with six goals in the second half. Peter Dryer, Alex Benedict, Jon Waldo, Tyler Schumacher, Grant Knight, and Brust all scored. Dryer and Brust provided the assists over the final 45 minutes of play. Casey Sullivan made two saves while posting his second shutout of the campaign.

The Yellow Jackets travel to Malone College on Friday for an AMC South Division encounter with the Pioneers at 5 pm. Cedarville will have an seven-day break before returning to action on Saturday, October 11th as the Yellow Jackets will battle AMC South Division foe Walsh University at 7 pm as part of Homecoming Weekend. Cedarville then makes the short trip to Columbus to face Ohio Dominican University on Tues., Oct. 14 at 4 pm in another important AMC South Division match.

High School - Named to the All-Ohio Division III First Team following his senior season at Mansfield Christian High School....posted 11 shutouts with 124 saves while leading his team to a 16-4-2 record.....named district Player of the Year.....earned a spot on the all-district first

team and the All-Independent Conference first team.....racked up nine shutouts with 74 saves as a junior at the school.....previously played two seasons at Lexington High School.....voted to the all-district second team in baseball as a senior.....led the area with a .514 batting average and 35 stolen bases.

### #3 John Sommer

John Sommer is back after missing nearly half of his rookie season with a foot injury but recently suffered a torn ACL that will sideline him the remainder of this season .....started the first 13 matches of the 2002 campaign with two goals and two assists for six points.....netted a goal with an assist in a 4-0 win at Taylor.....scored during a 3-1 AMC victory over Ohio Dominican.....assisted the game-winning goal in a 2-1 decision at Grace.....voted to the

American Mideast Conference South Division Second Team.

High School - Earned four letters during his career at Blackhawk Christian High School.....tied for the lead in the city of Fort Wayne in assists with 12 as a senior and was named to the all-area team.....also scored six goals for a 14-1-1 team that was unbeaten in their last 15 matches and led the city with 67 goals and 52 assists.....picked up all-district and all-academic honors.....all-state honorable mention.....served as student body president.....National Honor Society student.

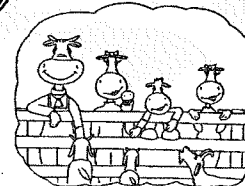
