### Tonight's Match



The Cedarville University men's soccer team hosts Urbana University tonight in American Mideast Conference South Division action at Yellow Jacket Field.

The Yellow Jackets enter tonight's contest unbeaten with a 4-0-2 mark and will seek to keep the streak going against the Blue Knights in an important AMC South Division matchup. Cedarville returns to action after pinning the first loss of the season on visiting Grace College (IN) last Saturday night by a 2-0 margin.

Urbana University is 2-2-1 overall including a 2-2 tie in two overtimes at Ohio Dominican University on Sept. 10 in AMC South Division action. The Blue Knights lost 2-1 in overtime to Capital University this past

Senior forward Jon Waldo leads the Yellow Jackets with 4 goals and an assist for 9 points. Junior midfielder Peter Dryer has contributed 2 goals and an assist for 5 points. Freshman forward Stephen Brust and sophomore midfielder Grant Knight have each added 2 goals to the Yellow Jacket attack. Cedarville has outscored their opponents by a 11-5 margin in the first six games of the campaign. Senior keeper Joel Reemtsma and junior keeper Casey Sullivan have combined to allow just .76 goals per game with each net-minder owning a shutout.

The Blue Knight men's soccer team returns all but two starters including 13 letter winners from last season's 14-6 squad. Urbana relies heavily on Urbana High School graduate Pat Thompson to lead the team in scoring. The junior forward posted nine goals and eight assists for 26 points last fall and was an AMC Second Team performer. There is also strength in the middle of the field for Urbana as senior Zach Weaver - an Honorable Mention All-AMC pick last vear - returns for his final season.





Cedarville leads the all-time series with the Blue Knights by a 13-1 margin with that only loss coming last season in a 2-0 shutout at Urbana. The Yellow Jackets have scored 75 goals in the series while allowing just 10.

### **Last Time Out**



Jon Waldo had a goal and an assist to lead Cedarville to a 2-0 non-conference victory over Grace in a battle of unbeaten teams. Joel Reemtsma made three saves in goal while recording his first career shutout. Waldo moved into 3rd place on CU's all-time goal scoring list when he netted his 52nd career goal in the 27th minute. He received a pass on the sideline, dribbled some 30 yards to the top of the box, and tucked a left-footed shot inside the near post. Waldo later tied the school's career record for



assists when he notched his 27th on a Peter Dryer goal in the 60th minute. The Jackets outshot the Lancers 11-5 overall and 6-3 in shots on goal. Cedarville did not allow a shot on goal in the second half.

Reemtsma earned AMC Defensive Player of the Week honors for his efforts in goal. The senior from Kenai, AK, bounced back from missing two games with an injury to blank Grace. It was the first collegiate shutout for Reemtsma who improved his 2003 record to 3-0-1.

The Yellow Jackets begin a three-game road trip that starts with a match at Marian College (IN) tomorrow afternoon at 2:00 pm. Cedarville visits Bethel College (IN) next Friday at 7 pm and AMC South Division foe Shawnee State on Sat., Sept. 27 at 4 pm. squad.....played four seasons of basketball with two letters.....tabbed the team's best defensive player on the hardwood as a senior.....ACSI Distinguished Student.


