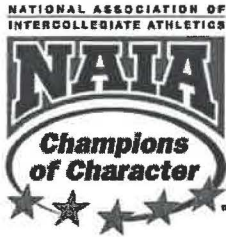

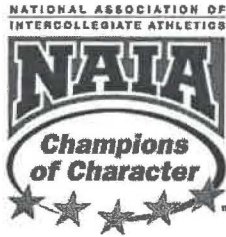
NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Rating No. 10 Indiana Wesleyan continues to be at the top of Women's Division II Basketball

OLATHE, Kan. - Indiana Wesleyan University looks poised for a run at the national championship, after retaining the top spot in the NAIA Division II Women's Basketball rating for the tenth consecutive week.

College of the Ozarks (Mo.) and the University of Saint Francis (Ind.) remained close behind at the No. 2 and No.3 positions, while Bethel College (Ind.) moved up two spots to No. 4. Cedarville University (Ohio) and William Jewell College (Mo.) both dropped one spot to No. 5 and No. 6, respectively. Menlo College (Calif.) and MidAmerican Nazarene University (Kan.) also moved up two positions to No. 7 and No. 8. Sterling College (Kan.) dropped two spots to No. 9 this week and Hastings College (Neb.) jumped six spots to finish out the top 10.

NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Rating No. 9 Indiana Wesleyan continues to roll atop Division II Top 25

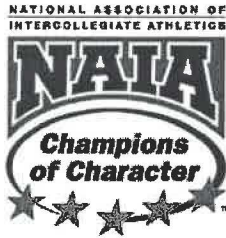
OLATHE, Kan. – Indiana Wesleyan continued its dominance of the NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Top 25, garnering all 17 first-place considerations to stay No. 1 in the ninth rating of the 2006-07 season.

Ozarks (Mo.) resumed its spot at No. 2, while Saint Francis (Ind.), Cedarville (Ohio) and William Jewell (Mo.) each moved up a spot to round out the top five. Bethel (Ind.), who was No. 3 last week, fell to No. 6 this week, and Sterling (Kan.) moved up two spots into the No. 7 position. Mount Marty (S.D.) climbed into the Top 10 at No. 8 this week, while Menlo (Calif.) and MidAmerica Nazarene (Kan.) round out the rating's first ten squads.

Only two teams climbed into the rating after being unranked last week, as Dakota State (S.D.) entered the poll at No. 18 and Taylor (Ind.) comes in at No. 22. The poll's biggest jump belongs to Hastings (Neb.), who climbed from No. 21 to No. 16 this week.

NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Rating No. 8 Indiana Wesleyan Tops Rating for Eighth Straight Week

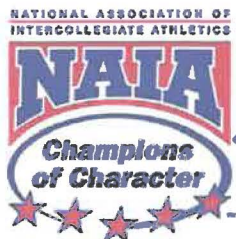
OLATHE, Kan. - For the eighth consecutive week, Indiana Wesleyan University remained No. 1 in the NAIA Division II Women's Basketball rating after improving their record to an unblemished 26-0.

College of the Ozarks (Mo.) kept itself in the No. 2 spot for the eighth straight week after going 2-0 on the week to improve to 23-2. Bethel College (Ind.), University of Saint Francis (Ind.), and Cedarville University (Ohio) all remained stationary in the No. 3, 4, and 5 positions.

William Jewell College (Mo.) moved up two spots to No. 6 and MidAmerica Nazarene University (Kan.) also moved up two positions to No. 7. Morningside College (Iowa) dropped one spot to No. 8, while both Sterling College (Kan.) and Menlo College (Calif.) both cracked the top ten after moving up four spots to No. 9 and No 10, respectively.

NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Rating No. 7 Indiana Wesleyan Remains Atop Division II Women's Top 25

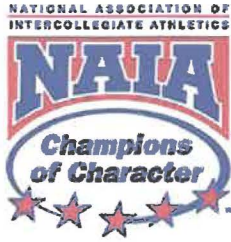
OLATHE, Kan. - Indiana Wesleyan University improved to 24-0 on the season and remains as the team to beat in NAIA Division II Women's Basketball, after once again being chosen as the unanimous No. 1 in the latest rating.

College of the Ozarks (Mo.) still awaits for Indiana Wesleyan to slip-up, as they remain the No. 2. There was some shakeup in the Top 10 this week though, as Bethel College (Ind.), University of Saint Francis (Ind.), Cedarville University (Ohio), Tabor College (Kan.) and William Jewell College (Mo.) all benefitted from MidAmerica Nazarene University (Kan.) and Morningside College (Iowa) suffering upset losses early in the week.

Mayville State University (N.D.) remained in the No. 10 spot, rounding out the top 10.

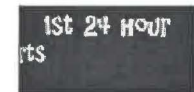

OLATHE, Kan. - Indiana Wesleyan University (21-0) continues to be the team to beat in NAIA Division II Women's Basketball, after being the unanimous No. 1 pick for the fifth-straight week.

College of the Ozarks (Mo.) (15-2) also held on to their No. 2 ranking for the fifth straight week, while MidAmerica Nazarene (Kan.) (17-1) and Cedarville (Ohio) (15-4) both moved up a spot to No. 3 and No. 4, respectively. Bethel (Ind.) (18-3) jumped three spots to No. 5, narrowly edging out No. 6 Morningside (Iowa) (14-5). Saint Francis (Ind.) (17-5) dropped four spots to No. 7, while three votes separated Mayville State (N.D.) (13-6), Tabor (Kan.) (16-2), and Bryan (Tenn.) (15-4) in the No. 8, No. 9, No. 10 positions.

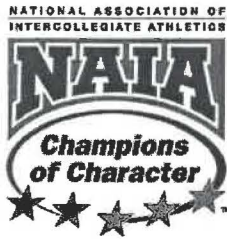

OLATHE, Kan. - Indiana Wesleyan once again received all first-place votes to stay atop the NAIA Top 25 Division-II Women's Basketball rating after remaining a perfect 17-0 so far this season.

Ozarks (Mo.) remained a spot behind IWU in second, while Saint Francis (Ind.) and Northwestern (Iowa) flip-flopped in the No. 3 and No. 4 spots. Mid-America Nazarene (Kan.) also cracked the top 5 for the first time this season moving up one spot to No. 5. Minot State (S.D.), Cedarville (Ohio), Bethel (Ind.), Tabor (Kan.), and Mount Marty (S.D.) round out the top ten.
