Melissa Thompson and Nicole James registered goals while Jessica Balsler notched her first career shutout to lead Cedarville to a 2-0 non-conference win at Earlham. Thompson got the scoring underway in the 21st minute with an assist from Krista Watson. James netted her team-leading fifth goal of the season in the 47th minute with Christie Zimmerman assisting. Balsler received her second start in goal and made three saves.

The Cedarville University women's soccer team hosts the Shawnee State University Bears this afternoon in American Midwest Conference South Division action. Cedarville enters the match with a 8-7-1 record (1-5 AMC) after posting a 2-0 shutout at Earlham on Saturday. Shawnee State University is currently 3-11 (0-6 AMC) after defeating Anderson University 3-1 on Saturday. Cedarville leads the all-time series between the two schools 2-0.

Freshman forward Nicole James continues to lead the Lady Jackets with 5 goals and 4 assists for 14 points. Another freshman forward, Candi Jelinek, had scored 4 goals and posted 2 assists before suffering a broken leg to end her season. Senior midfielder Alicia Anderson has added 3 goals and 3 assists on the season. Melissa Thompson, Chelsea Casto, Laura Radcliffe and Katie Thompson have each added 2 goals. Junior keeper Melissa Fawcett has allowed 27 goals in 14 games for a 2.11 gaa. Cedarville has been outscored by a 29-24 margin while holding a commanding edge in the corner kick category of 91-44. The Lady Jackets have pounded 212 shots on goal while allowing 167.

The Bears of Shawnee State are led in scoring by Laura Schulz and Marseille Markham, who have combined for 15 of the Bears' 18 goals this season. Schulz, a

sophomore midfielder, has 8 goals and 1 assist. Sophomore keeper Jessica Votaw has allowed 35 goals in 13 games and has posted 132 saves. The Bears have been outscored by a 38-18 margin while trailing in the shots on goal category 259-190.

Freshman forward Nicole James leads the Lady Jackets in scoring with 5 goals and 4 assists.
