Jane Adams returns for her third year following two outstanding seasons for the Lady Jackets.....scored 12 goals and posted 11 assists to tie her school record of 35 points set during her freshman season.....ranks second all-time in goals scored with 26 and third all-time with 70 points.....carries an Exercise Science major at Cedarville University.....born 8/10/82 in Holyoke, MA.....daughter of Mr. and Mrs. David Adams.....older brother, Dan, played two seasons with the Yellow Jacket men's soccer team.....also has a younger brother.

## LAST TIME OUT:

Laura Radcliffe, playing in her first collegiate match, scored twice to lead the Lady Jackets to a 2-0 victory at Oberlin last Saturday. The

freshman forward was on the sidelines with an ankle injury for the first four contests, but responded with a goal in the 60th minute on an assist from Chelsea Casto. Radcliffe answered again with three minutes left with Alicia Anderson and Nicole James assisting. Melissa Fawcett made five saves and picked up her first shutout of the season.

## UP NEXT:

The Lady Jackets travel to Malone College on Saturday for a 3:00 pm American Midwest Conference South Division match. The Pioneers are 3-0-2 overall and this will be their opening AMC South Division match. Malone leads the all-time series with the Lady Jackets 6-1-1. Malone defeated Roberts Wesleyan 4-0 on Saturday, Sept. 14 in their most recent outing. The Pioneers captured the 2001 American Midwest Conference title with a 15-0-1 record.

The Cedarville University women's soccer team hosts the Otterbein Cardinals in a non-conference match this evening at Yellow Jacket Field. Cedarville enters the match with a 3-2 record after posting a 2-0 shutout at Oberlin College on Saturday. Otterbein enters tonight's match with a 4-1 mark after defeating Hope by a 2-1 margin on Saturday. The Cardinals have won four consecutive matches after a season-opening 2-0 loss to Mt. Vernon Nazarene. The all-time series between Cedarville and Otterbein is tied 2-2.

The Lady Jackets continue to be led in scoring by Nicole James, a freshman forward from Honeoye-Falls, NY, with three goals and three assists for nine points. Alicia Anderson (SR, Fort Lupton, CO), Chelsea Casto (SO, Cayce, SC), and Laura Radcliffe (FR, Dayton, OH), each have two goals on the season. Jane Adams, (JR, South Hadley, MA), leading scorer for the past two seasons, continues to struggle with an ankle injury but hopes to see action tonight.

Goalkeeper Melissa Fawcett (JR, Cedarville, OH), has posted 25 saves while allowing 12 goals in five games. Cedarville holds an 88-64 edge over their opponents in shots on goal while dominating in corner kicks with a 31-13 margin.

After taking the Otterbein-Capital Tournament championship last weekend, Otterbein rolls into tonight's match with a lot of confidence. A large part of Otterbein's early success has been the play of senior midfielder Kristin Keen. Keen leads the team with

four goals and is among the Ohio Athletic Conference scoring leaders. Freshman goalkeeper Katie Chrien has registered 16 saves in 4 games while sharing the nets with junior keeper Sarah Jurak. Otterbein is a member of the NCAA III with an enrollment of 3,000.
