1989 NAIA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE AWARD

OFFICIAL CRITERIA

- I. Nominations for Scholar-Athlete awards must be submitted by official ballot from the baseball coach of the nominating institution.
- II. The nominated student-athlete must be a junior or senior varsity performer, certified by his institution's registrar as a fulltime student.
- III. The nominated student-athlete must have completed one full term of attendance at the nominating institution.
- IV. The nominated student-athlete must have at least a 3.25 academic average based on a 4.0 system or equivalent for all terms completed at the time of the nomination. Transcripts from all institutions attended must accompany the official ballot in order for the nominee to be considered.

TIMETABLE

All Scholar-Athlete ballots along with supporting material must be received by May 26 in order to be considered by the NAIA-BCA Scholar-Athlete Award Committee. Nominations will be reviewed by the Committee at a time and place selected by the Committee chairman.

SELECTION

The Scholar-Athlete Award Committee will select 30 members to the team: 10 infielders, 8 outfielders, 4 catchers, 2 designated hitters and 6 pitchers.
