Today's Match

The Lady Jackets return to the home turf where they are scheduled to play four of their final six matches. They have played seven of their first 11 matches on the road including the last four in a row.

Today is the third meeting between the two American Mideast Conference members with the home team winning the first two encounters. Cedarville posted a 2-0 win in 1998 while Geneva was a 1-0 winner last year in Beaver Falls, PA.

The Lady Jackets are coming off of a 6-1 victory at Ohio Dominican on Tuesday. Freshman forward Jane Adams scored three goals, Kristen DeVinney had two, and Lisa Hockenberry added the other. Michelle Ruhlman tallied two assists.

Adams leads the team in scoring with eight goals and four assists for 20 points. Ruhlman and Cindy Probus each have four goals. Senior goalkeeper Becky Kozlowski has a 1.39 goals against average and two shutouts.
