Today's Match

The Lady Jackets close out the regular season against the two toughest opponents on the schedule. The first obstacle comes up today in unbeaten Denison University. The Big Red, 15-0-0 overall, are ranked No. 9 nationally in NCAA Division III.

Denison has dominated the opposition this fall by outscoring them by a whopping 52-7 margin. What close matches they've had, they have won them all. The Big Red has a 4-0 mark in one-goal decisions including a 2-1 home victory over Kenyon on Wednesday.

Dana Grandmaison leads Denison in scoring with 15 goals and five assists for 35 points while teammate Sarah Finke has 11 goals and five assists for 27 points. Meghan Overom supplies seven goals with a team-high eight assists for 22 points and Liz Clapacs sports a 0.38 goals against average.

Michelle Ruhlman leads the Jackets in scoring and ranks second in the AMC with eight goals and six assists for 22 points. Kristen DeVinney has four goals with an AMC-leading eight assists for 16 points while Amber Bungart has scored five goals. Katie Mummau has a 1.12 goals against average.
