## Today's Match

The final two American Midwest Conference matches of the 1999 season for the Lady Jackets come against the top two teams in the standings. Malone College pays its first visit to Cedarville even though the schools have met three times previously in Canton. The Pioneers have won two of those contests.

Michelle Ruhlman leads the Jackets in scoring and ranks second in the AMC with eight goals and five assists for 21 points. Kristen DeVinney has four goals with an AMC-leading eight assists for 16 points while Amber Bungart has scored five goals. Katie Mummau has a 1.02 goals against average.

Freshman forward Sarah Ogle leads Malone in scoring with eight goals. Junior goalkeeper Aubby Rosado, last year's AMC Player of the Year, has a 1.18 goals against average. The Pioneers dropped a 2-1 home decision to Seton Hill on Saturday.

Cedarville opened play on its new home turf on Saturday with a 3-0 non-conference win against Marian College. DeVinney headed in two goals off of free kicks from Ruhlman. Amy Wiggershaus finished the scoring with an unassisted goal.
