## Today's Match

The Lady Jackets open the home portion of their 1999 schedule with a first-ever meeting with Marietta College in a non-conference match. Cedarville dropped their first three matches on the road, but they return to a home turf where they have posted an 8-3-2 record in their brief two-year varsity history.

The Jackets have been outscored 7-2 through their first three outings with Kristen DeVinney and Michelle Ruhlman, the field leaders of the squad, getting the goals. Cedarville has allowed six first-half goals thus far. Senior Katie Mummau returns to her goalkeeper position for the first time since getting injured in the 65th minute of the season opener.

Marietta, an NCAA Division III institution who is a member of the Ohio Athletic Conference, has a 4-2-1 record. The Pioneers opened their schedule with an impressive 5-2 decision against Geneva. Marietta has outscored the opposition 20-6 with Anne Eadie netting five goals and Amber Oliver adding four more.

## Lady Jacket Profile - Kristen DeVinney



Kristen DeVinney, who is one of the team co-captains, is the only player in Cedarville's brief two-year soccer history to have played and started in all 31 matches.....Only player to start all 19 matches last fall and she ranked third in scoring with four goals and a team-high seven assists for 15 points.....Named to the American Mideast Conference First Team and ranked fourth in the league in assists.....In 1997, finished the Lady

Jackets' first varsity season as the team's leading scorer with 10 goals and one assist for 21 points.....Named to the NCCAA All-America Second Team and to the All-NCCAA Midwest Region Team.....Scored a school-record four goals during a 9-0 rout at Huntington which was the program's first victory.....DeVinney was a four-year letter winner in soccer at Perry NY High School.....Played on three divisional championship squads, was named to the all-conference team three times, and she led the league in scoring as a junior.....Dean's List student at Cedarville as a Nursing major.....Born 4/25/79.....Daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Donald DeVinney.....Has one older sister and one older brother.
