The remainder of the 1999 soccer schedule favors the Lady Jackets beginning today against American Midwest Conference foe Seton Hill College. Seven of the final eight matches will be on home turf including the last six in a row. The final road trip comes on Tuesday at Notre Dame College.

Today is the second meeting between Cedarville and Seton Hill, who is in its first year as an AMC member. Last year, they played to a scoreless tie in Greensburg, PA.

Michelle Ruhlman leads the Jackets in scoring with five goals and three assists for 13 points. Kristen DeVinney has one goal with a team-high five assists for seven points. Katie Mummau sports a 0.81 goals against average.

Cedarville is coming off of a 7-0 romp at Urbana on Tuesday. Ruhlman had two goals and one assist while Amber Bungart scored twice. Seton Hill blanked Saint Vincent, 2-0, at home on Thursday.

Katie Mummau is the lone senior on the 1999 roster and serves as one of the team's co-captains.....The Mechanicsburg, PA product started all 29 matches in which she played in 1997 and 1998 including all 19 matches last fall.....Has logged all but 300 minutes in goal during the Lady Jackets two-year history.....Ranked fifth in the AMC with a 2.40 goals against average.....Posted 3.5 shutouts including a 2-0 win over league foe Geneva.....In 1997, quickly established herself to be the Lady Jackets number

one goalkeeper.....Voted to the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) All-NAIA Great Lakes Region First Team as sponsored by UMBRO.....Recorded a school-record 24 saves during a 0-0 tie against Tiffin.....Earned letters in both soccer and basketball at Mechanicsburg High School.....Honored to play in the Senior All-Star Soccer Game in 1996.....Carries an Athletic Training major at Cedarville College.....Born 10/17/78.....Daughter of Mr. and Mrs. George Mummau.....Has two older brothers and one younger sister.
