How Some Coins Were Named.

The origin of the names of coins in present use is curious. In many cases they imply a standard of weight that lost its significance long ago. This is the case with the English standard, the pound. The word shilling is of German derivation, like penny, which comes from the German pennig. The word crown comes from the image placed on the coin. The name franc was given by King John, who first coined these pieces in 1360. They bore the motto "Le Roi Frank" (King of the Franks) and were of two kinds, one representing the king on horseback, the other on foot.
