## **Lady Jackets look for winning season in 1992-93**

Cedarville College head women's basketball coach Kathy Freese hopes to take her program a notch higher this winter. The Lady Jackets were 15-15 last season, but the second-year mentor is always looking for ways to improve.

"One of our main goals is to continue to get better," says Freese. "We want to see each player improve and last year we made tremendous strides in that area."

"As a team, we'll strive to play an uptempo game. We have added more team speed and I again plan on using a lot of players. The key to all of this is depth and we have more this year."

The top returning player is senior Amy Zehr. The 5-9 forward averaged 15.8 points and 11.2 rebounds per game last year in being named to the NCCAA All-America second team. She needs just four points tonight to become the sixth player in Lady Jacket basketball history to total 1,000 for a career.

Mindy Humble joins Zehr as a three-year letterwinner. The 5-5 senior guard is Cedarville's all-time leader in three-pointers made and attempted. She has played in 79 games the past three years and has started all but one.

Three other seniors, Denise Headdings, Kim McCoy, and Cinnamon Brown will be expected to make a contribution this season. Junior guard Rachel Howard, who started 29 games last year, is out until January because of a knee injury she suffered in August, and classmate Sarah Stiles returns to the program after sitting out last year.

Sophomore forwards Christine Copeland and Shaundra Randolph received significant playing time during their rookie years. This winter's freshman class of Becky Cave, Melanie Fraley, Melissa Hadley, Melissa Hartman, Melissa Pitonyak, and Becky Zomer will all be vying for court time.

**TONIGHT'S OPPONENT** -- Kentucky Christian College is a school of 475 students located in Grayson, KY. They are a Division II member of the National Christian College Athletic Association (NCCAA).

The Lady Knights enter tonight's game with a

3-0 record. This is the first-ever meeting between the two schools in women's basketball.

**LADY JACKETS LOOK FOR FIRST WIN** -- The Lady Jackets are 0-2 on the young season after losing at Malone (79-55) and at Georgetown, KY (76-66).

In the most recent outing Tuesday at Georgetown, Amy Zehr tallied 21 points and 15 rebounds, while Melissa Hartman added 17 points. The host Lady Tigers are considered to be one of the top NAIA teams in Kentucky.

In last Saturday's setback at Malone, neither Zehr nor Hartman played because they were competing for the Lady Jacket volleyball team in the NAIA District 22 Tournament.

**WILMINGTON TOURNAMENT** -- Cedarville will play Hanover tomorrow night at 6:00 in the first round of the Wilmington Tournament. The host Quakers face Wilberforce at 8:00.

Saturday's consolation game will be at 1:00 with the championship to follow at 3:00.
