## *Lady Jacket Profile:*

## **Cinnamon Brown makes the grade in three years**

Cedarville College senior center Cinnamon Brown is in the process of closing out a three-year career in Lady Jacket basketball and tennis. It's not because she elected only to play three years or the fact that she transferred in after spending a freshman year somewhere else.

Brown came to Cedarville as a freshman with the rest of the Class of '94 three years ago, but she will finish her academics and graduate one year sooner than the rest of her classmates. While she accelerated her progress to a three-year program, she didn't sacrifice quality work.

Cinnamon was presented the June F. Kearney Award last year in recognition as the top female scholar-athlete at Cedarville College for 1991-92. She had a cumulative 3.95 grade point average as an English/professional writing major. She was also selected to the NAIA All-America Scholar-Athlete team in women's tennis.

Brown has played in all 11 games this season for the Lady Jackets with one start. She has scored 26 points and hauled in 28 rebounds. Her best effort came in a 90-68 win at Taylor. While she only tallied three points, she had seven rebounds and five steals.

"Cinnamon is a good inside player," states Lady Jacket coach Kathy Freese. "She is aggressive, deceptive, and gives us depth at the post position."

Brown was a member of Cedarville's NAIA District 22 and Mid-Ohio Conference championship tennis team last spring. She had a 10-4 season record in singles, and was the only Lady Jacket to win a singles match at the NAIA Nationals.

Cinnamon is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Jonathan Brown of Fremont, Indiana.

**FOR THE RECORD** -- Cedarville College tied a 24-year old school record on Saturday with its ninth straight win, a 72-57 decision over Bluffton in the Athletic Center. The 1968-69 Lady Jacket squad won their first nine games of the season before losing their last one in a 9-1 campaign. Amy Zehr had 19 points and 14 rebounds against Bluffton and Becky Cave scored 13 points.

**TODAY'S OPPONENT** -- Lake Erie College is an institution of approximately 760 students located in Painesville, Ohio. The school is a Division II member of NAIA District 22.

Cedarville holds a 3-0 series lead over the Storm including two victories last year. The Jackets won 83-60 in Painesville, and 77-71 in the Athletic Center.

Lake Erie enters today's game with a 2-4 record.

**NEXT GAME** -- This evening's game is the last one prior to the holidays for the Lady Jackets. The final 14 games on the schedule will all be in Mid-Ohio Conference play.

The women begin 1993 with a three-game week the first full week of January. They play at Mt. Vernon Nazarene on the 5th, and then return home to host Ohio Dominican on the 7th, and Urbana on the 9th.
